**SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 12
SKILLS OF NATIVE TRADITION**

- 11 AM Corn is Life** (1982, 19 min.) By Donald Coughlin. Introduced by Nadema Agard, Museum of the American Indian. The central sustenance of Hopi life, corn is seen in its traditional uses and methods of preparation.
- 11:30 Tule Technology** (1983, 42 min.) By the University of Nevada-Reno in cooperation with the Office of Folklife programs, Smithsonian Institution. Introduced by Thomas Venum, Jr. Four examples of Northern Paiute craft—a duck egg bag, duck decoy, traditional house and boat—made of tule reed and cattails, filmed in Nevada in 1964 and 1979.
- 12:30 PM The Pame Indians of Santa Maria Acapulco** (1981, 32 min.) By Antonio del Rivero for the Instituto Nacional Indigenista, Mexico. A small Mexican mountain community and its crafts are profiled during the harvest season.
- 1:15 Summer of the Loucheux** (1983, 28 min.) By Graddon McCrea. Introduced by Mary Jane Lenz, Museum of the American Indian. Reflections of members of the Loucheux family at their traditional summer fishing camp in northern Canada.

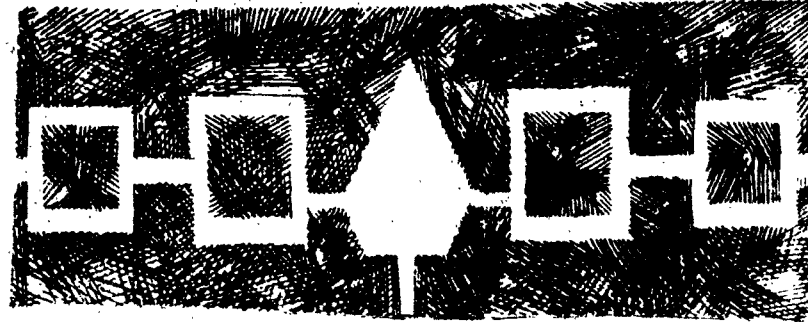
**SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 13
CULTURAL SURVIVAL**

- 11 AM Letter from an Apache** (1983, 12 min.) By Barbara Wilk. Introduced by filmmaker. The life story of an Apache man based on his 1905 letter and told through animation and archival photographs.
- 11:20 Rope to Our Roots** (1981, 30 min.) By Bo Boudar. Profiles the 1980 Inuit Circumpolar Conference at which Eskimos from Alaska, Canada and Greenland discuss their common concerns.
- 12:00 PM Box of Treasures** (1983, 28 min.) By Chuck Olin Associates. Executive Producers: The U'Mista Cultural Society. Introduced by G. Peter Jemison, American Indian Community House. A Kwakiutl leader gives an account of the cultural destruction experienced by her people and how a renewal is being achieved.
- 12:40 Haa Shagoon** (1983, 30 min.) By Joseph Kawaky. Introduced by the filmmaker. A Tlingit elder discusses a traditional peace ceremony which he has sponsored for his community's well-being.

SPIRITUAL WAYS

- 1:30 Mitote Tepahuano** (1981, 30 min.) By Rafael Montero for the Instituto Nacional Indigenista, Mexico. The celebration of ancient sacred songs and dances in a northern Mexican community in the Durango Mountains.
- 2:15 Spirit of the Hunt** (1983, 30 min.) By Deborah Peaker. A modern version of the age-old practice of a communal buffalo hunt shows the hunt and the spiritual acts which accompany it.
- 3:00 Arctic Spirits** (1983, 27 min.) By Peter Raymond. Introduced by the filmmaker. The Great Spirit Within the Holan investigation of the rise of the evangelical movement among Inuit people in the Canadian Arctic.
- 3:45 The Great Spirit Within the Hole** (1983, 60 min.) By Chris Spotted Eagle. Introduced by the filmmaker. Interviews with Native Americans in prison demonstrate the significance of traditional spiritual practices and underscore the importance of the 1978 American Indian Religious Freedom Act.

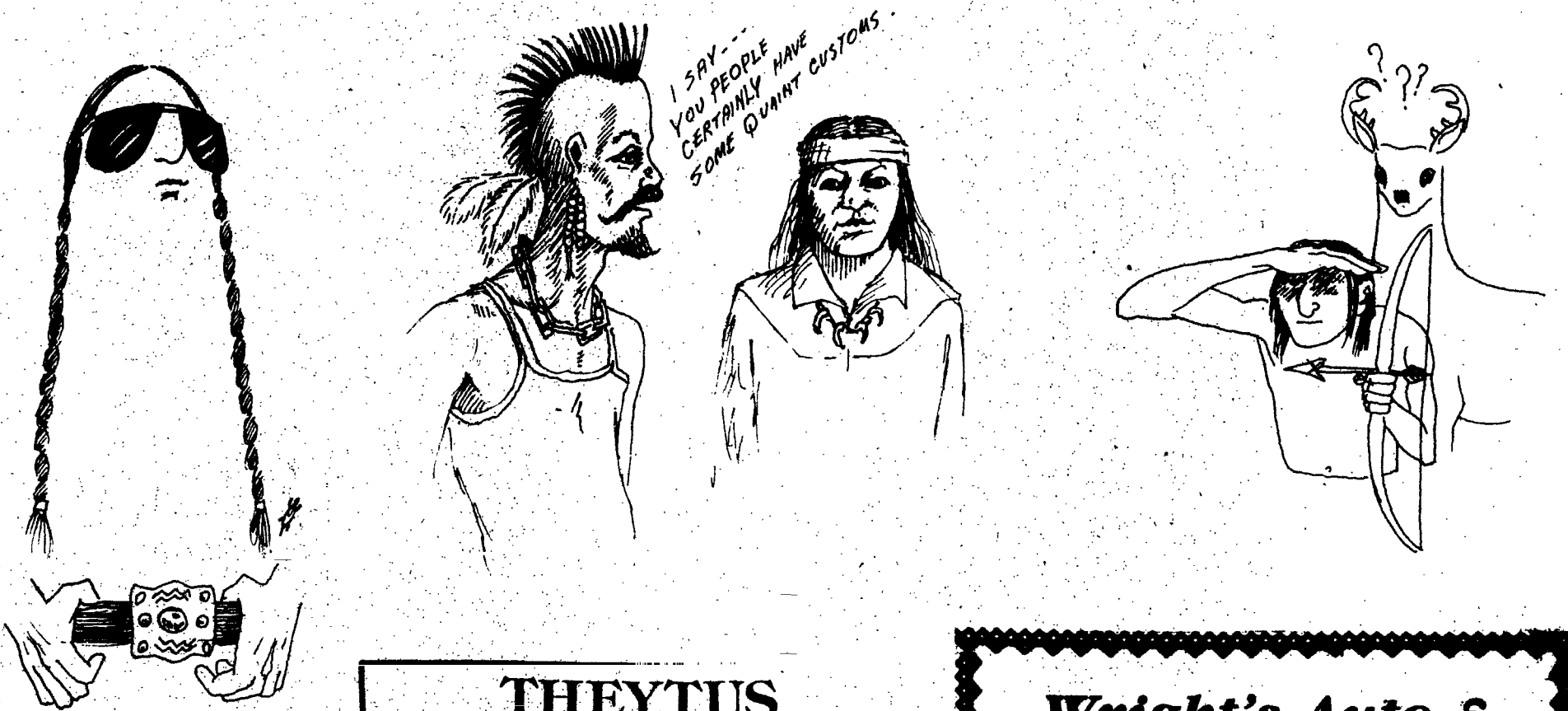
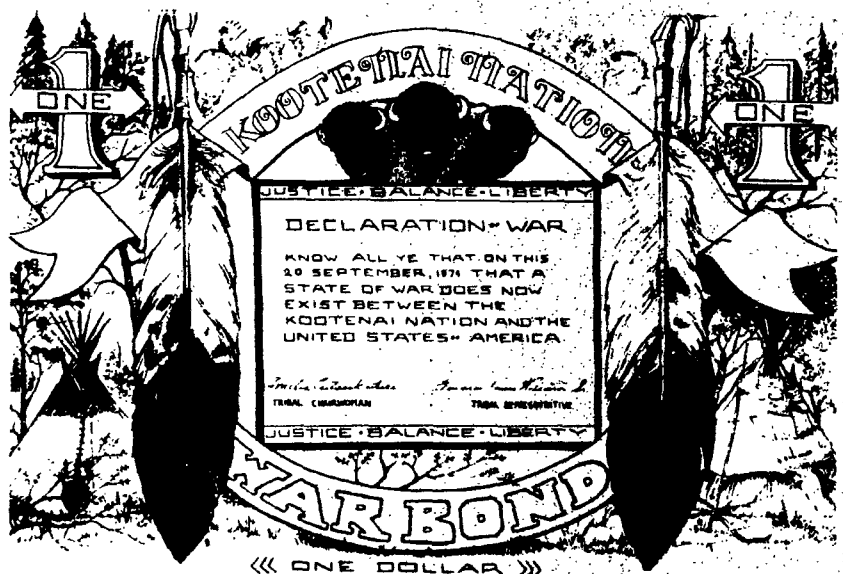
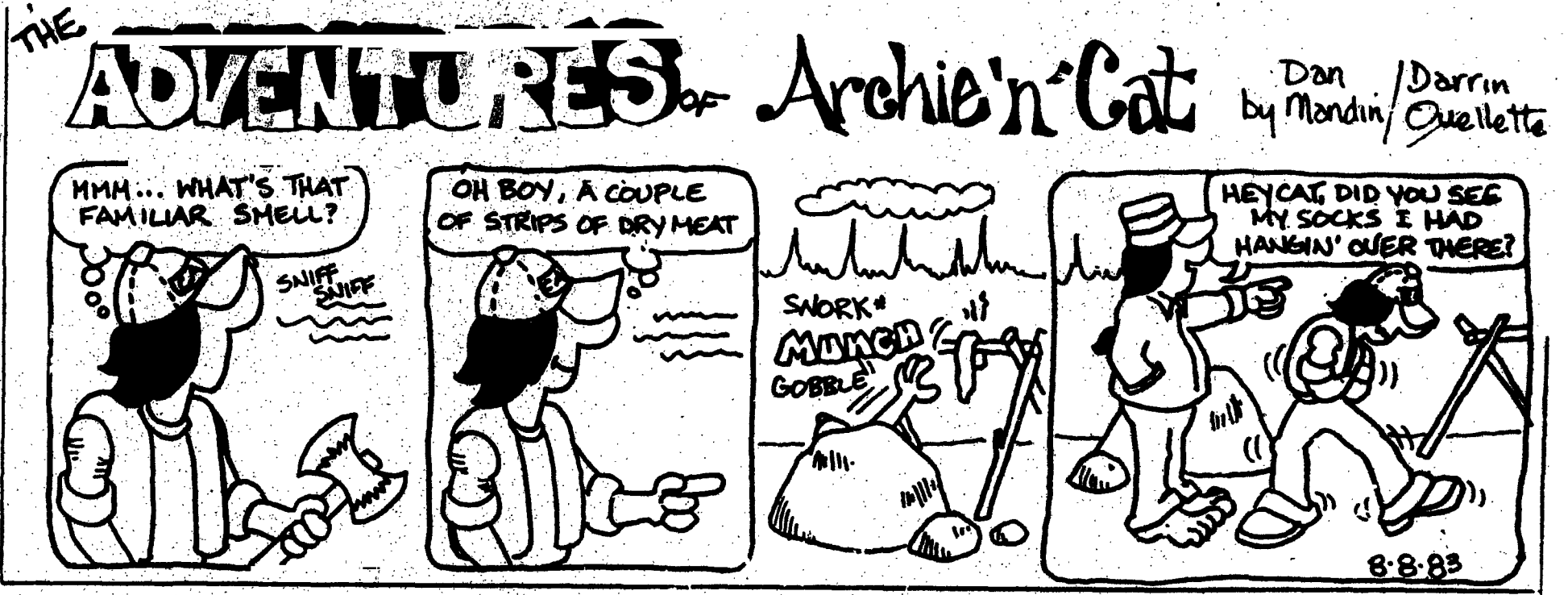
