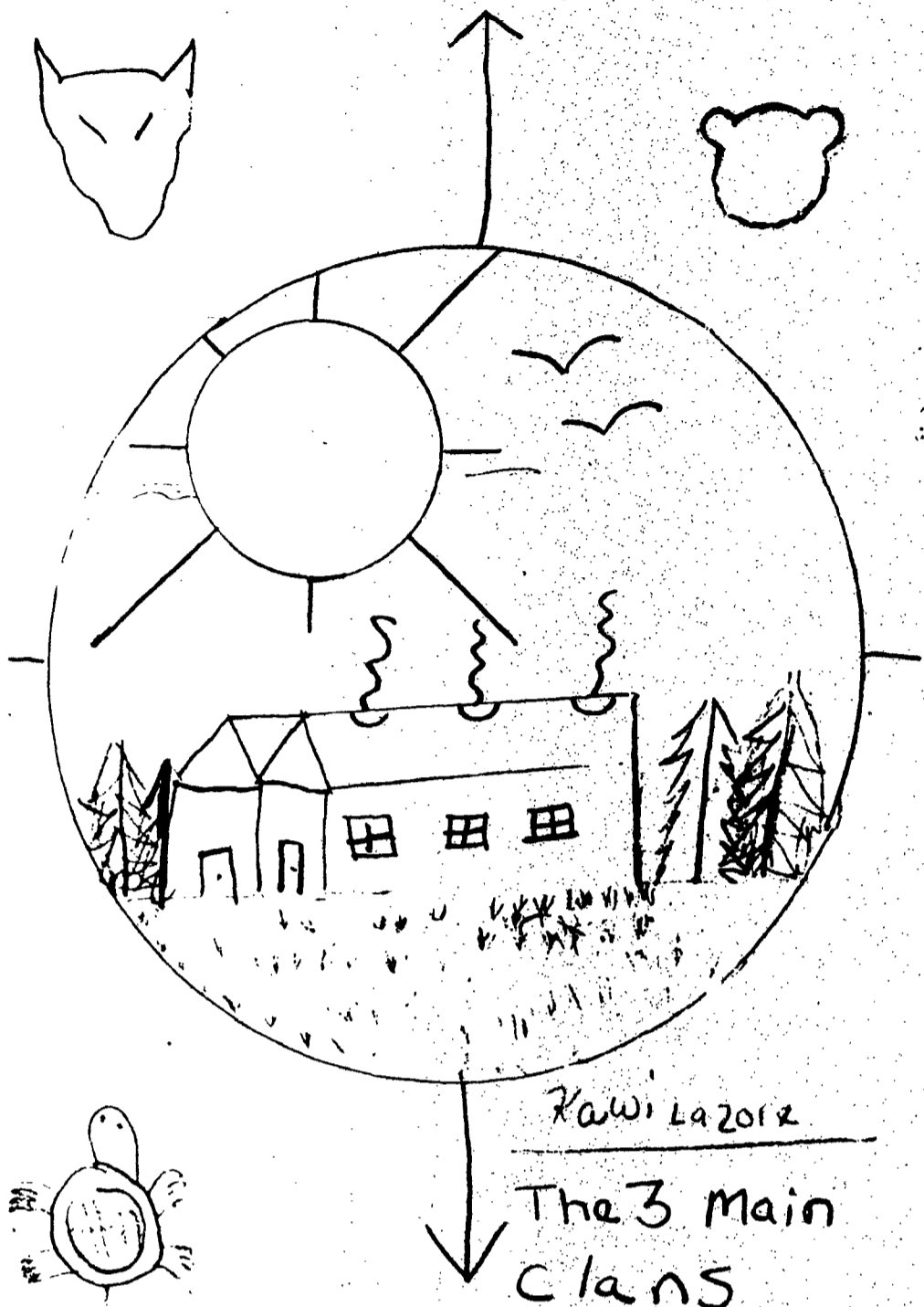

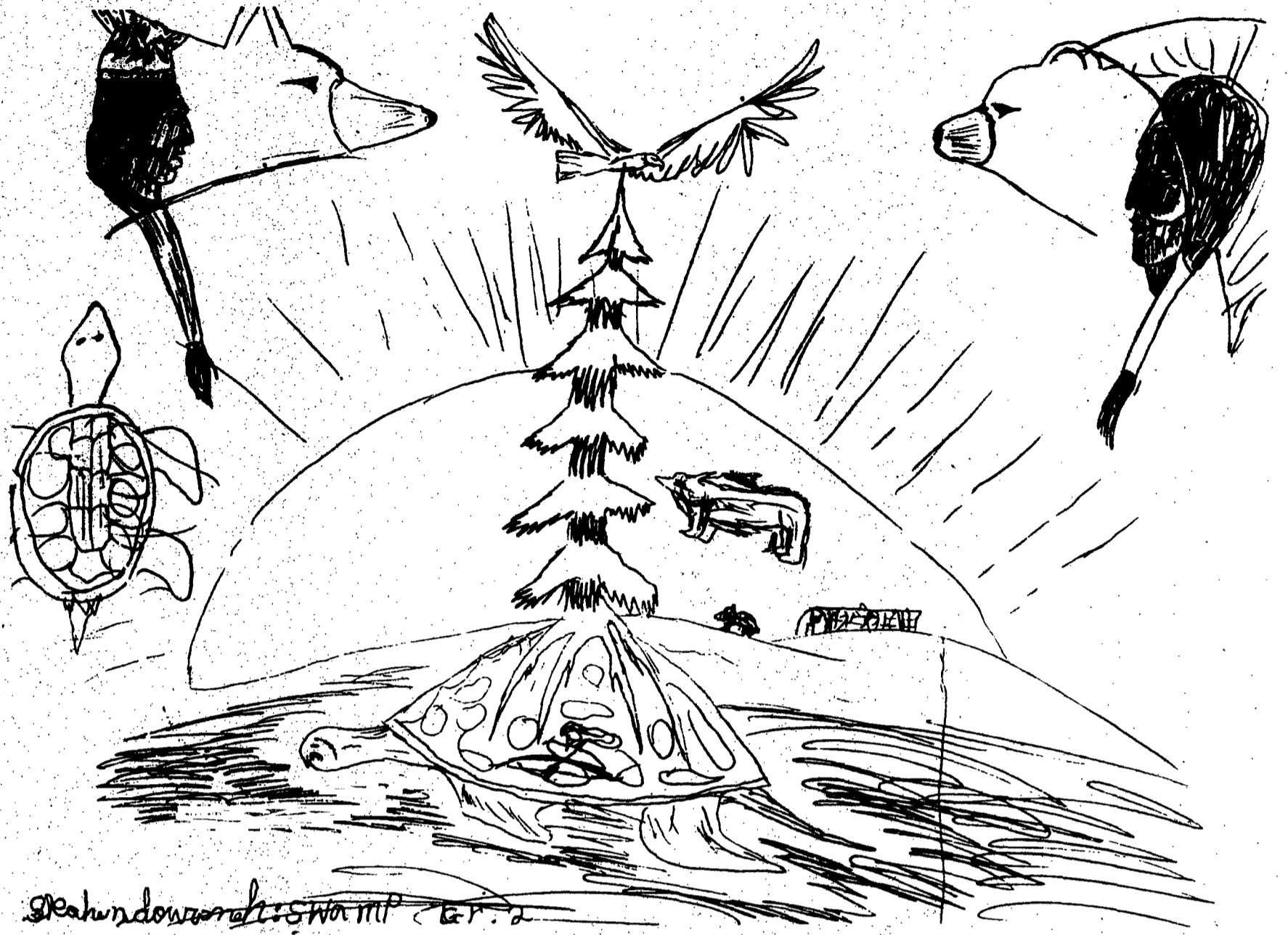

## From the students of the Akwesasne Freedom School

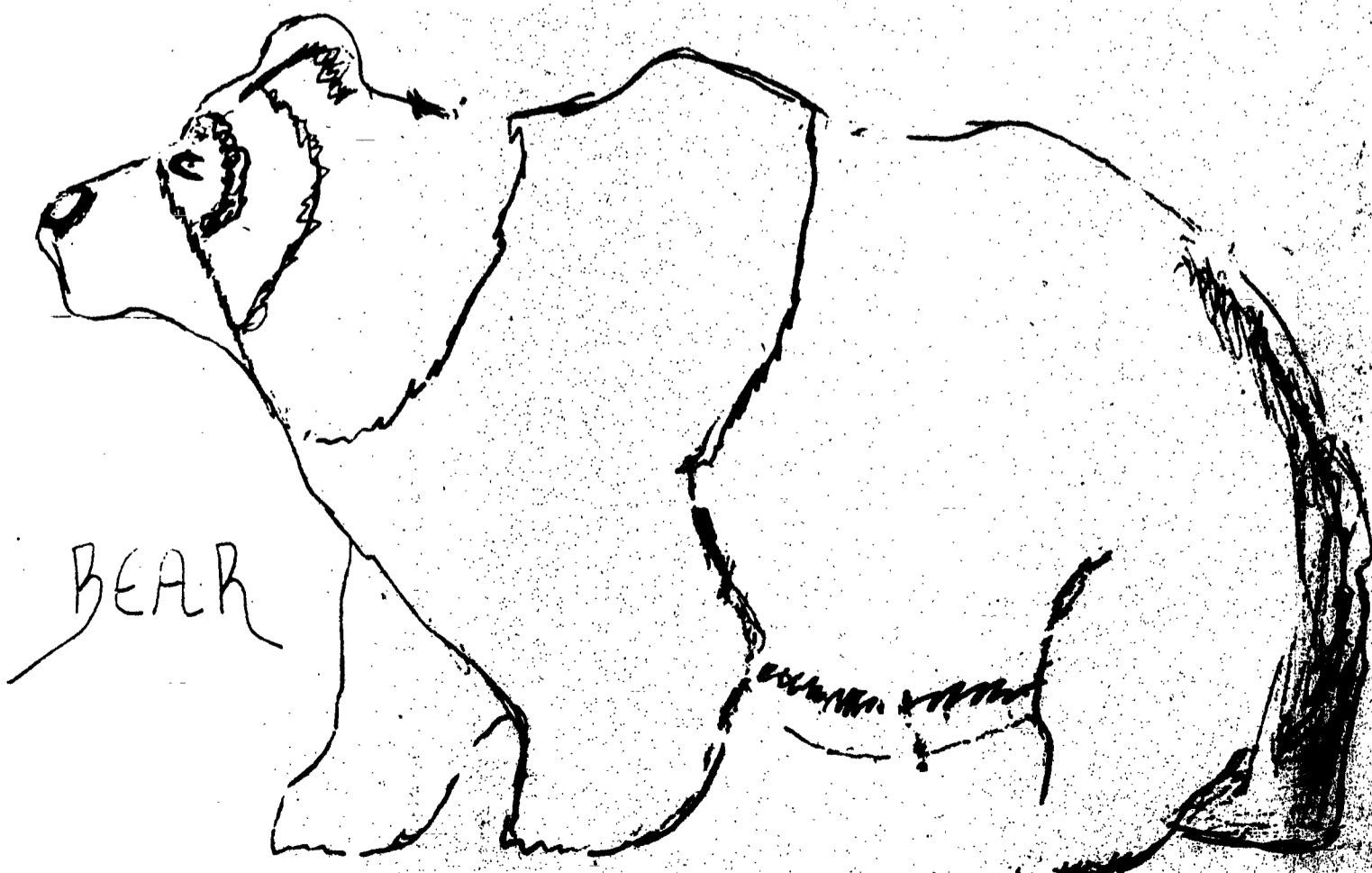
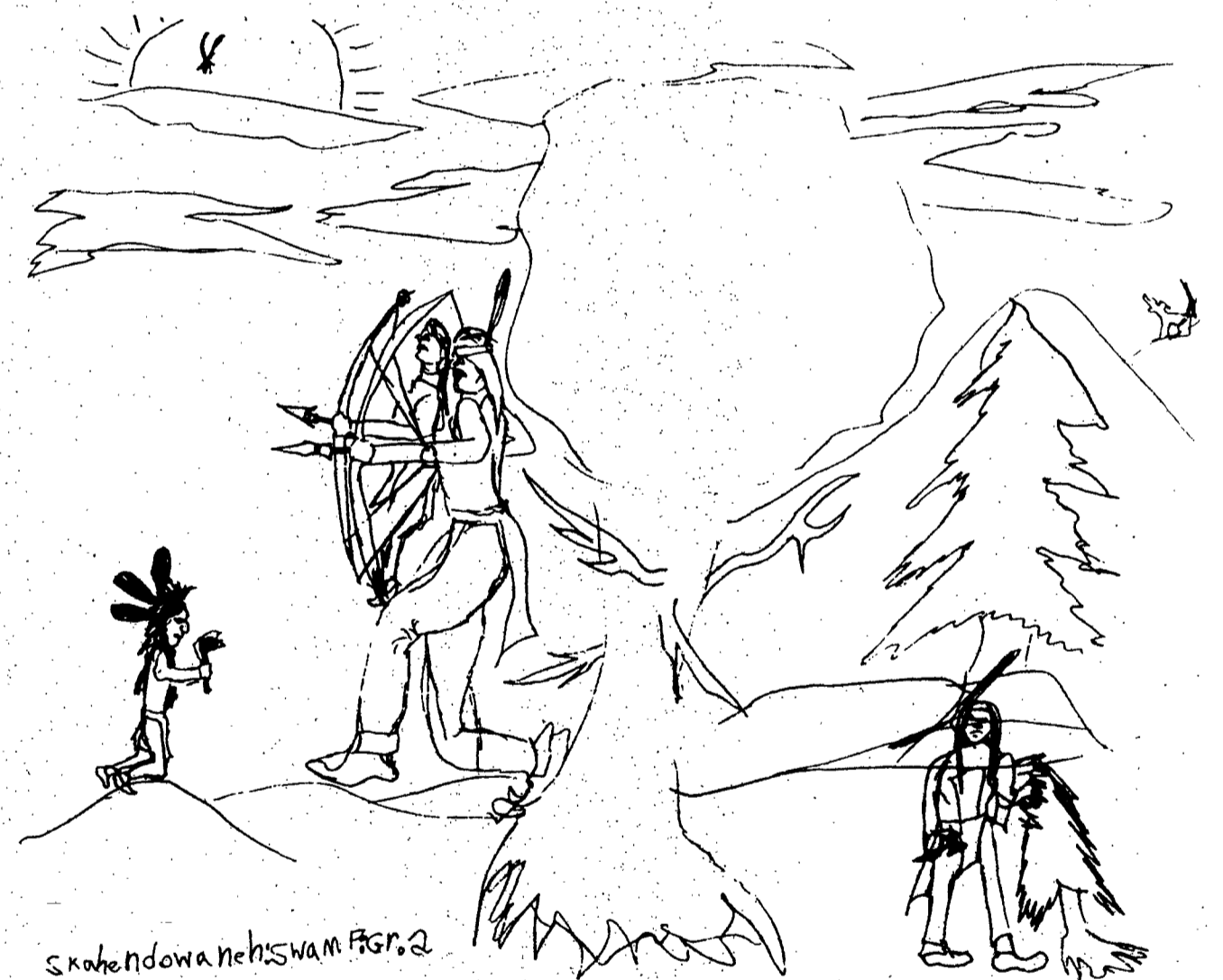
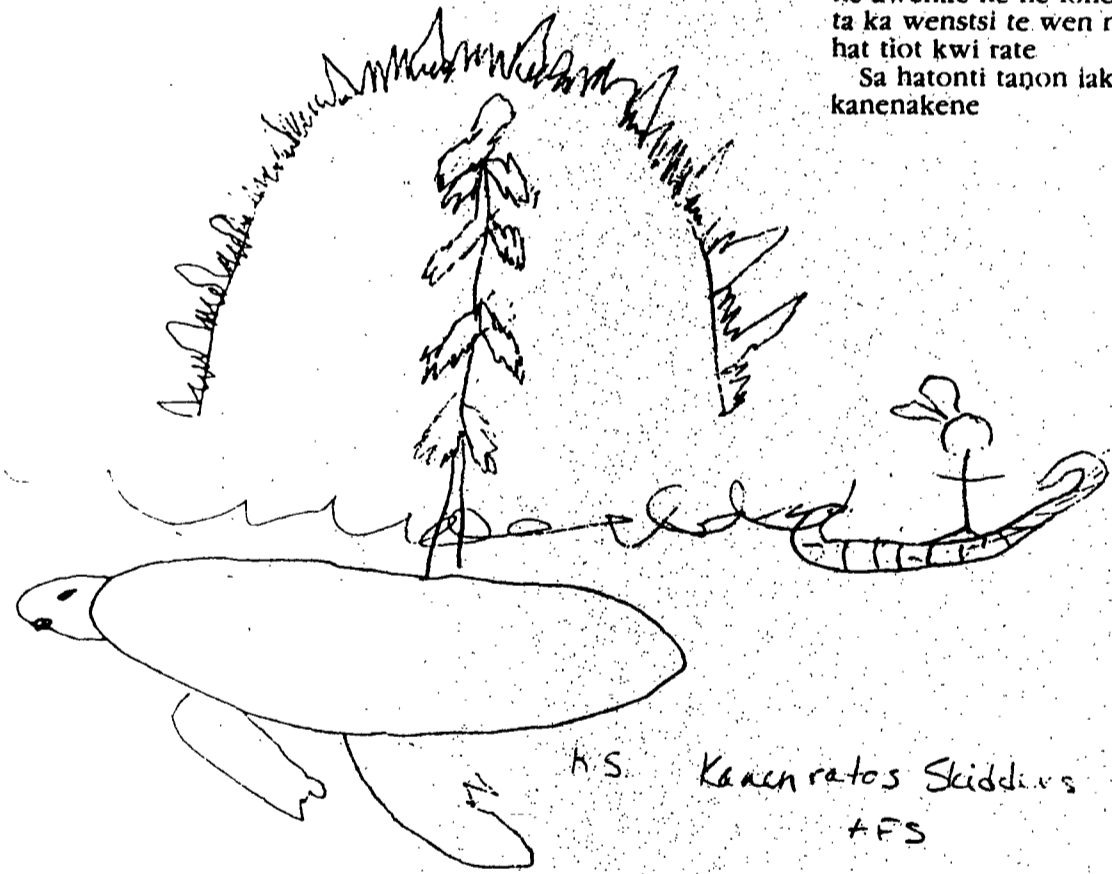
**Green House**
