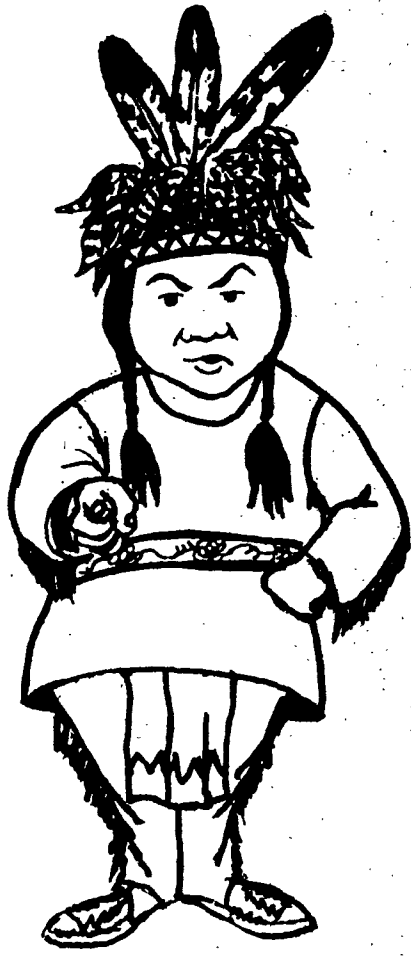

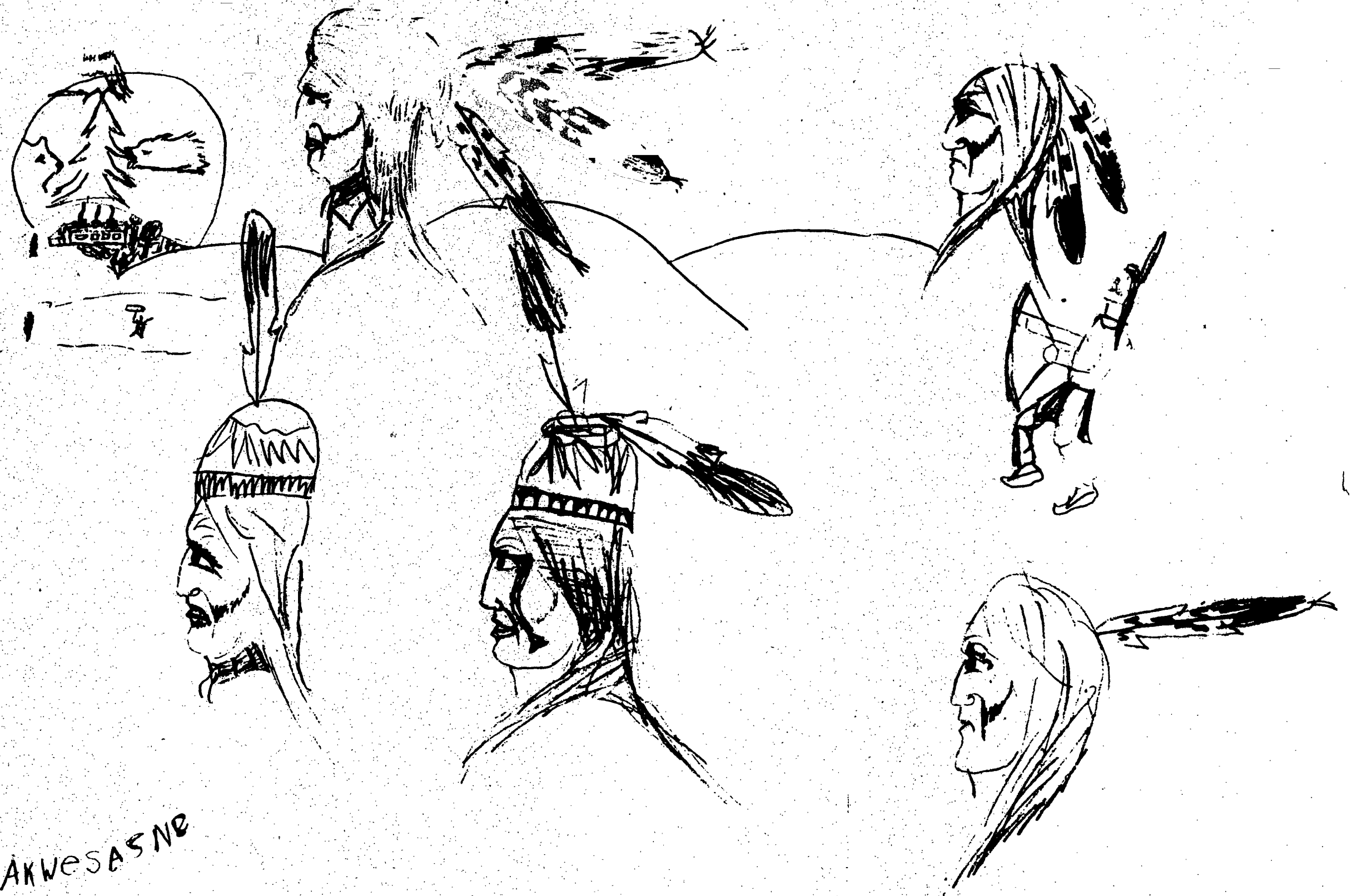
We Want You!!

But sometimes it rains and it gets muddy and then we have to wear rubber boots.

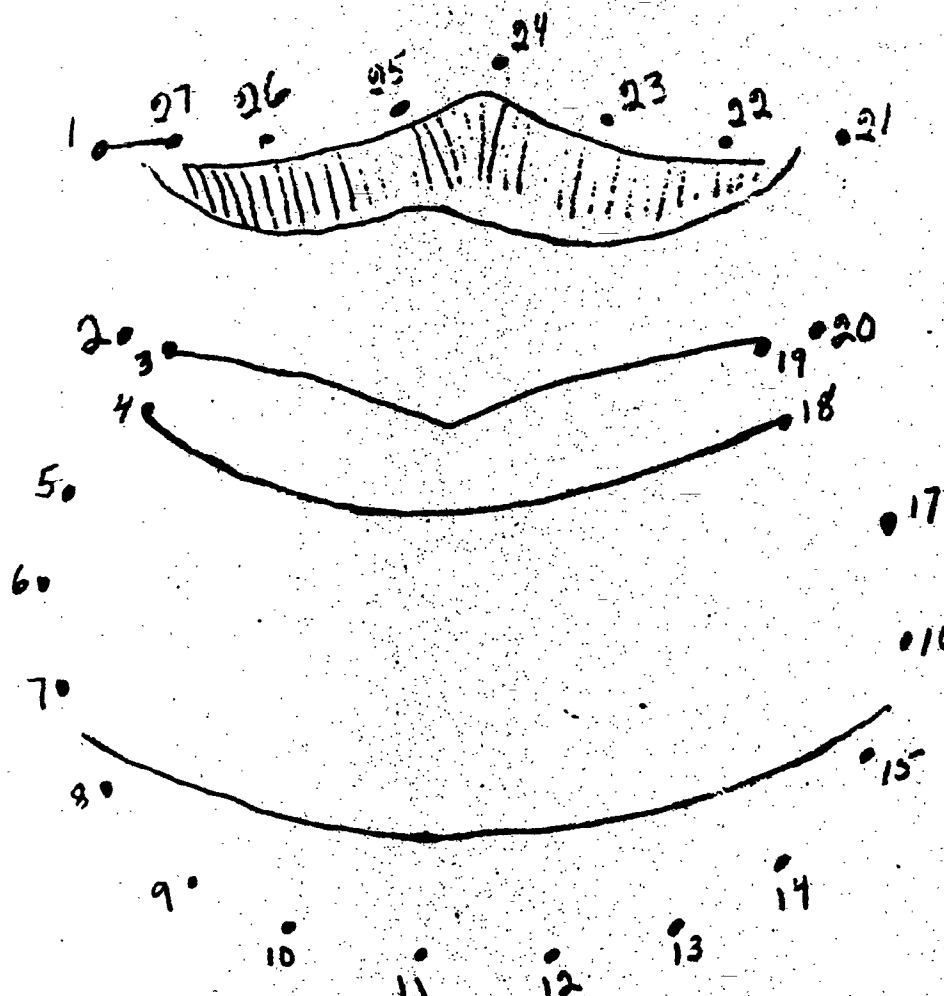

WHAT AM I?

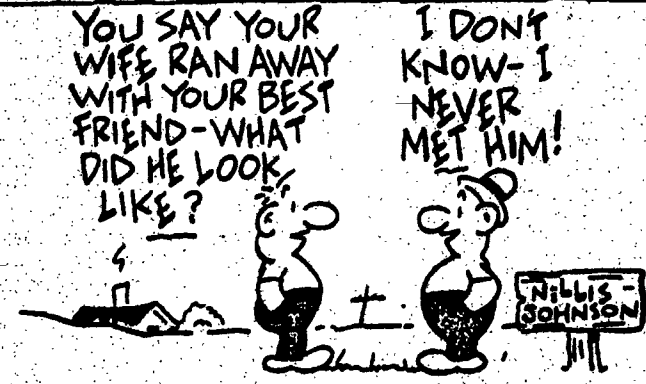
I am made of clay.
