AMERICAN INDIAN CAREER OPPORTUNITIES IN EARTH SCIENCES

N.S.F. YOUNG SCHOLARS PROGRAM

Location: Smoky Mountains, Tennessee, Date: June 18 through July 1, 1989. For: American Indian (Eastern Tribes) students who will enter 9th grade in Fall, 1989. Cost: All costs are covered, Application Deadline: May 1, 1989.

A two week field experience that will demonstrate the need for Native American scientists to assist in planning for their reservation and will outline career opportunities in the earth sciences.

The goal of this program is to stimulate young American Indian Scholars to pursue career in areas of the earth sciences that relate to proper use and maintenance of the earth, both on and off their reservations. We will explore with them the use of geology in maintaining the environment while accommodating population growth and economic development. This study would include such things as the prevention of groundwater contamination, landslides, deforestation, and excess erosion. We will also explore the particular need for people in this discipline when developing economic and energy resources on Indian lands.

The objective of this effort will be to encourage young American Indian to prepare themselves for geologic careers in such areas as environmental geology, geophysics, hydrology, petroleum geology, engineering geology, mining geology, and geochemistry. At present, the American Indian is a very under represented minority group in geologically intensive industries. Development of reservation lands is sometimes slowed because tribal leaders are afraid to have industry either modify their reservations or mine their resources. They need professionally trained Indians to advise them in future development while protecting tribal interests and cultures. This project will apprise the young scholars of the opportunities that would be available to them as geologists and of the need for geologists that exists on reservations.

Lydia Pesata, a Jicarilla Apache from Dulce, New Mexico, will demonstrate her expertise in basketry at the Museum of the American Indian. She has been weaving baskets for more than 25 years and her baskets are woven in the traditional Apache manner. Lydia's grandmother-in-law, Tanzanita Pesata, taught her the art of basket weaving. Gathering the materials and different plants (for dyes) from the land, she incorporates beautiful traditional designs and finishes the baskets with a traditional braid weave.

Presently at the Jicarilla Apache Reservation Cultural Center in Dulce, which she helped to found in 1980, Lydia is acknowledged by her peers as a skilled artist and has been honored with many awards. Her baskets are in the collections of the Heman Homestead in Evergreen, Colorado, the Cimarron Museum in Cimarron, Kansas, and the Museum of Natural History in Denver, Colorado.
