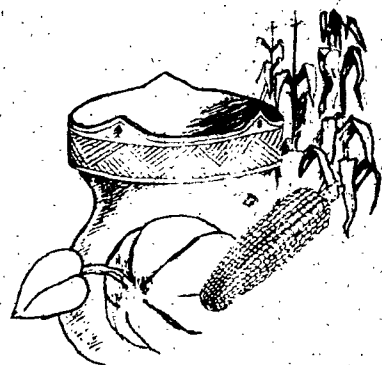

Baked Rice Pilaf

Preheat Oven to 350 degrees
2 cups long grain rice
1/4 cup diced celery and onion
3 tablespoons chicken soup base
5 cups of water
4 tablespoons vegetable oil
In a deep frying pan, fry onion and celery in two tablespoons vegetable oil until tender, add rice, fry or sautee until the rice is clear, add chicken soup base and water. Cover, bake in over for one hour or until liquid disappears. Serves 6 - 8 people.

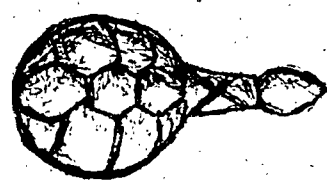
Cornwall Regional Art Gallery

The Cornwall Regional Art Gallery is calling for proposals for 1991/92 exhibitions, open to multi-media artists, photographers, printmakers, and painters, also fine crafts people for the Gallery Shoppe. Send 10-15 slides of work indicating the date they were executed; a curriculum vitae; a proposal indicating the intent or theme of the exhibition, including an approximation of the number of pieces; a self-addressed envelope for safe return of the submission.

Submission deadline is April 20, 1990. Slide submissions may be sent by mail to the Cornwall Regional Art Gallery, P.O. Box 1822, 164 Pitt Street Mall, Cornwall, Ontario, K6H 6N6. Unframed works should not be delivered before the week of April 15, due to lack of storage space.

Higher Education

Opportunities for Native Americans in higher education are there, says George Cornell, but not enough Indians are graduating from high school to take advantage of them. "The high school dropout rate is the biggest educational problem for American Indians," he says. Cornell directs MSU's Native American Institute, one of few in the U.S. He also teaches history and is concerned about what he describes a majority college students' "functional illiteracy about the contributions of diverse groups." He says: "There is no way you can understand the history of this country without knowing about the contributions of American Indians and other groups." Contact Cornell at (517) 353-6632.



Craft Work Wanted

The Adirondack North Country Crafts Center (ANCC) in Lake Placid wishes to obtain work from the craftspeople in Akwesasne. One option open to you is to submit your work on consignment. A second option is to submit five (5) to ten (10) slides of your work into their Slide File for wholesale and other buyers. It is not necessary to have material left on consignment to be represented in their Slide File. The ANCC is operated by the Adirondack North Country Association, which serves the fourteen counties of upper New York State. ANCC functions as a year round showcase of regional craftwork, offering quality work in a range of types and prices.

If your choice is to offer slides of your work for wholesale and other buyers, you must complete a craft producer file form (a single sheet). You may write to ANCC or come into the Planning Office for a craft producer file form. You mail your slides and the completed craft producer file form into ANCC and your slides will be placed in the Slide File.

If you are interested in leaving your work on consignment, you must examine their requirements and return the appropriate information to the ANCC. The material detailing the requirements can be obtained from the Planning Office or the ANCC. Your work will be juried by the ANCC. Jurying is done at least once a month. If your work is accepted, you will sign a consignment agreement which explains all the benefits and requirements. The ANCC store manager is Eileen Kurtz. Her address is as follows:
