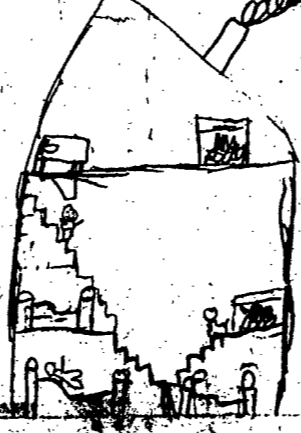

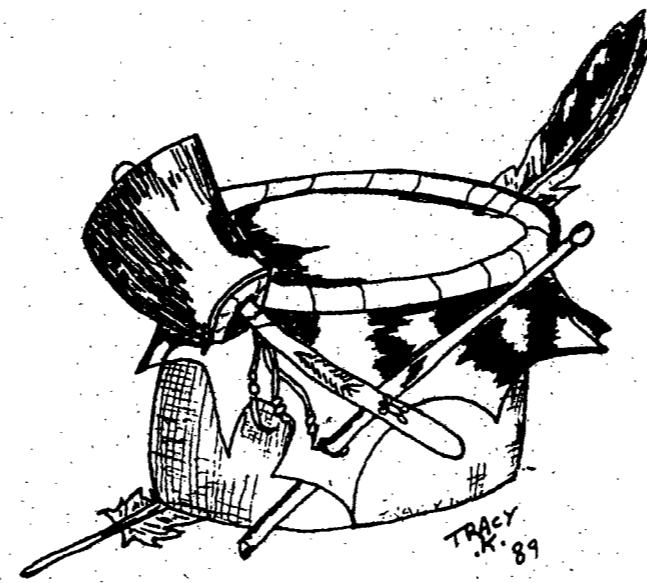

Please try not to get hurt. I am going to bring you some books. And please try to go back to your house and not get in the war.

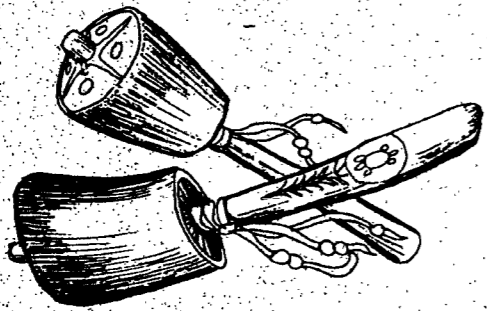

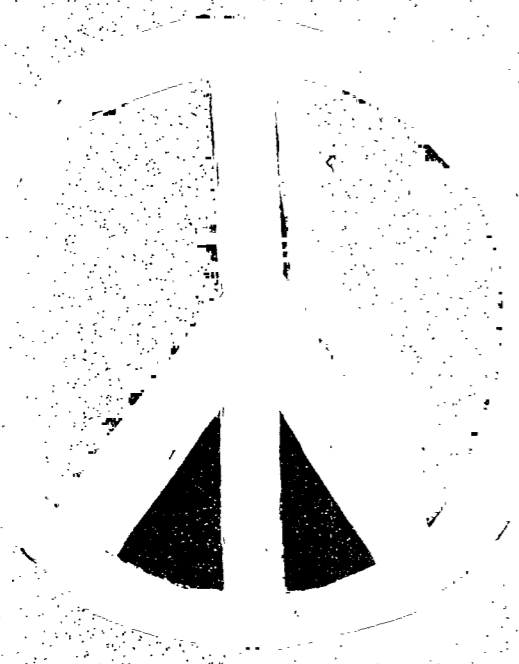

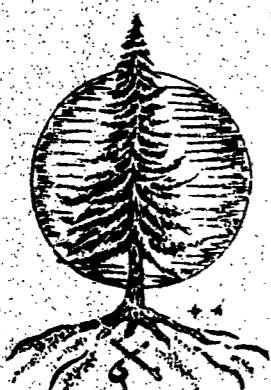
