What we've accomplished:

- All of the jobs and businesses we've created have been legal and had benefits: \$4.1 million MCME contracts, Bonding, Computerization of Tribe, Waterline Extensions, Staff to Tribal Clerk's office, expanded Tribal programs, Mohawk Woodworks, SOAR Development program .
- We've secured funding to expand the waterline to Hogansburg and build a \$1.5 million waste water treatment system.
- We've strengthened the Mohawk Education Committee.
- We've built a 10 bed Partridge House Treatment Center.
- We've supported two cultural summer camps for Mohawk youth.
- We've consistently made written proposals to solve the gambling/roadblock crisis
- We proposed peace forums, courts, policing agreements, and local proposals over the past 2 years.
- We've supported all legitimate businesses at Akwesasne.
- We've refused to involve people with criminal records in our government.
- We've made our Environmental Task Force a leader in the cleanup of our land, air, and water.

It's important because:

- All Mohawks have a right to live in Akwesasne and a right to their opinion.
- If we are to heal our often bitter disagreements, our leaders must show us the way.
- Our Mohawk identity is based on having a good mind to achieve peace, non-violence, and the common good.
- Now we've turned the corner on crime and it's time to do things the legal way.

We will keep working for you by:

- Achieving self-sufficiency through legitimate economic alternatives.
- Creating partnerships with individual Mohawk business people.
- No discrimination in hiring.
- Job security: We won't use your job to make you do what we want.
- A rational community development plan.
- Neighborhood decisions on land use.
- Make U.S. and Canadian companies pay for pollution.
- We will not sell out to G.M.
- Create jobs in the cleanup of our land and rivers.
- Establishing an accountable, professional, non-political police force that is NOBODY'S goon squad.
- Holding peace and healing forums for individuals, families, factions, and leaders so we can continue to live together.
- Enforcing drug abuse laws and strengthening drug and alcohol treatment programs, such as the Partridge House.
- Building a new Mohawk school.
- Establishing a Tribal Unemployment Insurance Program for all Mohawk citizens--it's your right!
- We will get the people's approval for the Tribal/State compact on legal gambling.
