COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT PROPOSAL FOR EDUCATION

THE CANADIAN CONSTITUTION GUARANTEES NATIVE PEOPLE THE RIGHT TO EDUCATION, BUT THE EDUCATION SYSTEM THAT THE CANADA ENVISIONED FOR NATIVES WAS MODELED AFTER A PROVINCIAL SYSTEM. THE MOHAWK COUNCIL OF AKWESASNE SHARES THE FIRST NATION'S VIEW THAT A SUCCESSFUL SELF-DETERMINATION IS DEPENDENT UPON THE QUALITY AND CULTURAL REINFORCEMENT AVAILABLE IN THE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM. INDIAN EDUCATION SHOULD REFLECT AND ENHANCE EVERY ASPECT OF OUR MOHAWK SOCIETY.

IN 1987, THE DEPARTMENT OF INDIAN AFFAIRS TRANSFERRED THE ADMINISTRATION OF EDUCATION TO THE AKWESASNE MOHAWK BOARD OF EDUCATION. ACCORDING TO THE CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENTS BETWEEN MOHAWK COUNCIL OF AKWESASNE AND THE DEPARTMENT, THE COMMUNITY IS STILL ACCOUNTABLE TO THE MINISTER FOR ITS OPERATIONS AND EXPENDITURES OF FUNDS. THE PRESENT SYSTEM PREVENTS THE AKWESASNE SCHOOL BOARD FROM DEFINING AND ACTING UPON THE COMMUNITY'S OWN PRIORITIES.

The Current Shortages In Education

- There is a shortage of :
1. Counseling staff to elementary and secondary children
 2. Assistance to needy families with such things as clothing
 3. The development of materials for the survival of the Mohawk language program, and other curriculum materials that reflect Mohawk culture
 4. Formula funding that allows equitable pay scale benefits and services
 5. Funding which is provided to the three separate school districts as one school
 6. Special education which is based on a percentage of all students instead of all students instead of individual needs.
 7. Mohawk Council of Akwesasne input in the policy development, ie. facilities and equipment.

The present formula provided for funding of Native children in provincial schools greatly outweighs the monies contributed to the Akwesasne Mohawk Board of Education. These outdated inadequacies must be changed. Previously, the Akwesasne Board was obligated under the Indian Affairs guidelines to return excess monies instead of using it in special education programs where it is needed or building a reserve fund for school maintenance, and facilities, etc. The Mohawk Council has also negotiated with the federal government to provide whole day funding for pre-k and kindergarten sessions. Previously, these classes were funded for half day sessions.

MOHAWK COUNCIL'S POSITION

In the future, the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne intends to negotiate education jurisdictions, new funding arrangements and other matters, such as transference of education credits. It is the Council's aim that an improved legislation will remove the Minister's powers pertaining to education and take precedence over the sections (114-121) in the Indian Act.

No jurisdiction or authority of an outside government will affect the administration of Mohawk Council policies and planning regarding education. This also means the authority delegated to the Akwesasne Mohawk Board of Education will be recognized not only by the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne, but by the Federal government. The Board will be allowed to develop curriculum guidelines reflecting the actual needs of our students. As the Board develops the special needs, (such as learning disabilities, social adjustments and enrichment programs) will be implemented into the education program. The guidelines will include Mohawk standards in conjunction with provincial guidelines.

The legislation will also affirm the federal government's responsibility for the provision of adequate financing so our children can receive the highest quality education possible and also implement pride and knowledge of our cultural heritage into our school system.

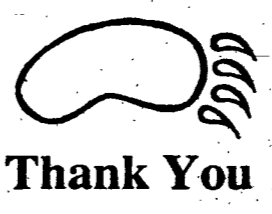
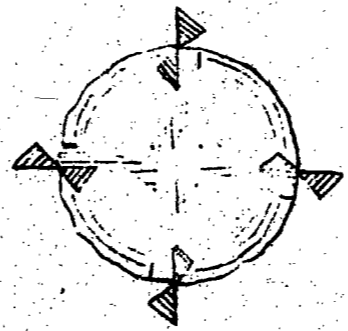
The improvements in education programs can only be negotiated with the community's knowledge, input, and support.

Court upholds Superfund lien

EPA's authority under the Superfund Act to file liens against potentially responsible parties has been upheld by a federal court in Massachusetts. The decision, the first test of the constitutionality of a Superfund lien, is the upshot of EPA's notice issued in March 1989 against the owners of property that included a 26 square-mile PCB site. The Norwood site, added to the National Priorities List in 1986, could cost \$20 million to clean up. Owners of the property, John and Paul Reardon, claimed they were not responsible for the contamination on their property and should be considered "innocent landowners" under CERCLA. They claimed that the action was a violation of their due process rights under the Fifth Amendment and a deprivation of property. The court dismissed the claim, holding that the act bars judicial review of an enforcement action.
