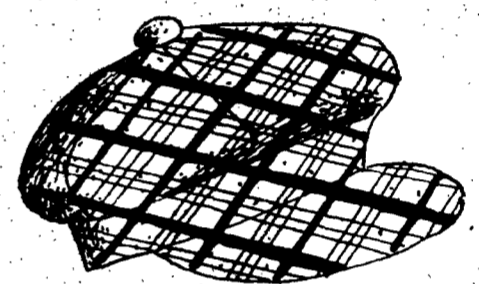

Clothespin Fence

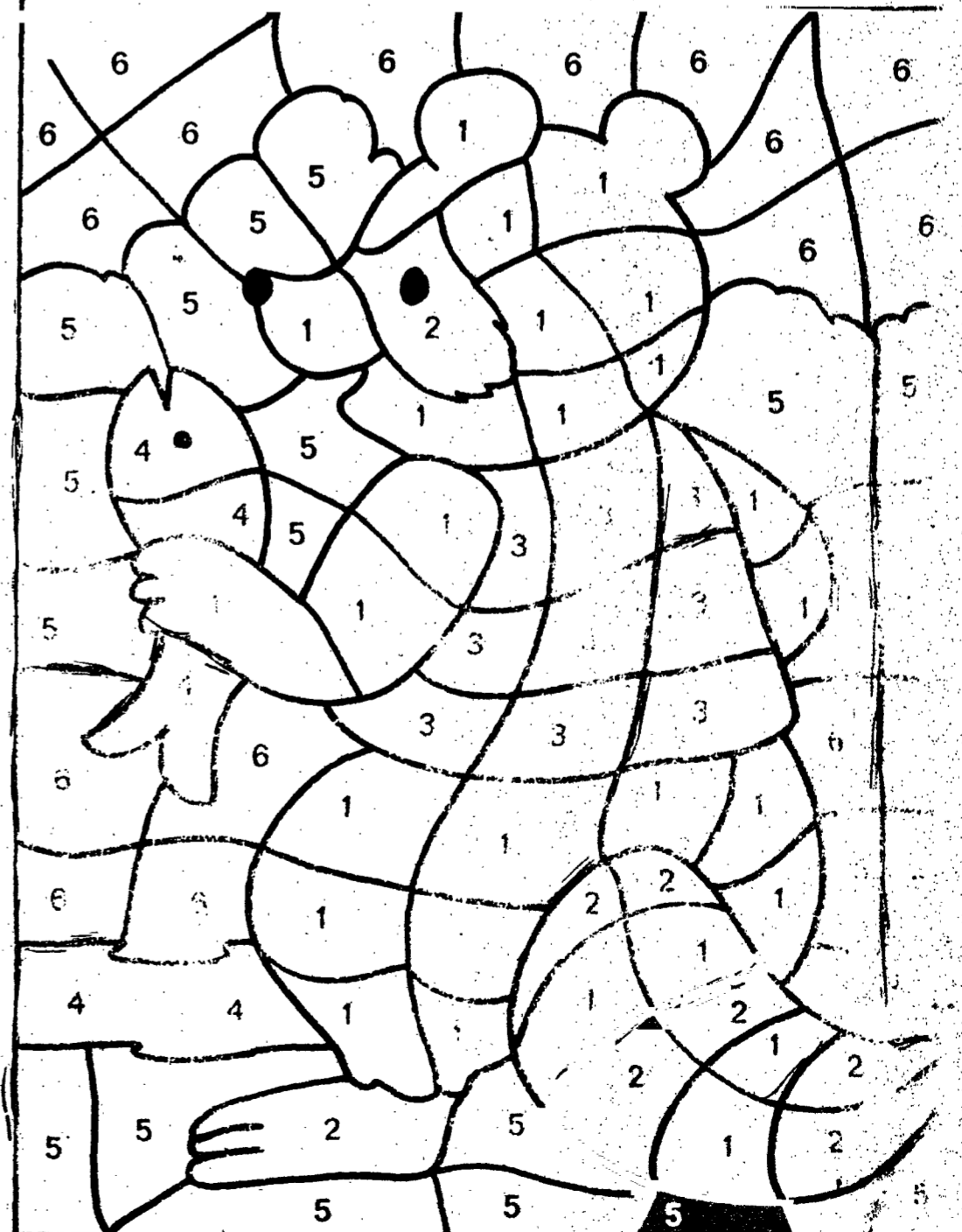
You can do so many things with clothespins. Here is a clothespin play idea that is easy and lots of fun.
