Canada Employment Center For Students

Canada Employment Center for Students makes it easier for students to find summer jobs.

Located at 139 Montreal Road in Cornwall, C.E.C.S. has four student placement officers on staff to help young people fill out applications and identify prospective employers. They also have helpful information on scholarships and government programs, as well as help in filling out required forms. They also keep track of application deadlines for various government agencies who hire students for the summer.

Many private businesses and homeowners contact them with part-time opportunities. Interviews can be held in the C.E.C.S. office and applications for many employers are available there as well.

To encourage more businesses to hire students, next week is designated as "Hire A Student Week." They also sponsor an "Employer Of The Week" award for companies that take on and train students during the summer.

Because many high school guidance offices are closed during the summer, college information is also available for the students.

Students who would like to start a business of their own are also encouraged to stop in. Applications and information are available for acquiring government loans.

Leah Gilmour says the Student Center is looking for more involvement from Native students and employers from Akwesasne. Ms. Gilmour, along with Native intern Terry MacDonald, will be visiting Mohawk businesses during the coming weeks to answer questions and advise owners on programs available to them.

2. Knowledge of Traditional Mohawk culture an asset
3. Must have Diploma or certification in teaching from U.S. or Canada

4. Prior teaching experience an asset
5. Have knowledge and awareness of the current teaching trends in the teaching of children.

6. Recognize that learning is essentially an individual process and be capable of adjusting different teaching techniques to individual children

7. Be able to establish a good rapport with children, parents, other teachers and administration

Major responsibilities

1. Instruct students in Mohawk language all basic subject matter; including math, science, spelling and reading

2. Instruct students in Traditional culture including: Thanksgiving Address and Ceremonial cycle

3. Evaluate student progress and maintain records

4. Be involved in the development of curriculum material and in reading, writing and language program

5. Communicate with parents to discuss students progress

6. Other duties as designated by the Director

The Akwesasne Freedom School is a Mohawk Immersion School. The curriculum is twofold, one we stress our Traditional culture through the ceremonies, the study of the Great Law (grades 5 and 6) and base our science on the Thanksgiving Address. Two, the school teaches all subjects in Mohawk including Math, Reading, Science and Spelling. Teachers will have the full use of the outdoors for science projects, unlimited use of Community Resource People such as our Elders, Faithkeepers and Traditional Chiefs. We stress the whole child language learning with academics.
