

### Charisma Recruiting Native American Models

### Excellence in Education Award

The Native American Scholarship Fund, Inc. (NASF) announced that it will give two awards of \$5,000 each for excellence in Indian education on September 1, 1992. One award will go to the individual in the U.S. who has achieved the highest level of excellence with Indian students. The second award will go to the institution in the U.S. which has done the best job.

Any individual or school serving Indian students in the U.S. from the preschool level to post-college level, can apply. There are no restrictions on the use of the funds. Any field of effort is eligible, with no restrictions being placed on either. Some examples of possible outcomes, among many others are math, science, attendance, retention, college entrance rates, parent commitment to students' education, curriculum development, testing, test score improvement, improvements in grades, improvement in levels of employment of graduates, and improvements in student evaluation.

The most important criterion for the award will be that students have actually improved in some area and that this improvement can be documented. Applications received without documentation of improvements will be screened out of the competition. Only documentation on improvements for Indian students is to be included with the application.

### Akwesasne By-Law

Again we must remind the owners and operators of All Terrain Vehicles of the Akwesasne By-Law pertaining to these vehicles. The By-Law states:

For the safe and responsible use of all terrain vehicles, motorcycles and mini-bikes:

Whereas There has been an increased amount of accidents reported by the Akwesasne Police Department involving three/four wheelers, motorcycles, and mini bikes, the following resolution has been introduced.

Therefore The Mohawk Council enacts the following By-Law regarding the safety and regulating the above mentioned vehicles.

The Akwesasne Police Department will respond in the following manner:

A) Any vehicle identified driving reckless at high speeds that

endangers the safety of others while driving on public roads and public property, or without benefit of safety attire, will be charged and their vehicle impounded and faced with a levy of fines.

B) 1st. Offense: \$50.00 fine  
2nd Offense: \$200.00 fine  
3rd Offense: \$500.00 Fine and confiscation of vehicle.

Any damage incurred as a result of property damage caused by operation of these vehicles, will be the responsibility of the operator and owner of the vehicle.

If you own or operate an All Terrain Vehicle and request more information as to the Safe operation of All Terrain Vehicles, please feel free to contact the Akwesasne Mohawk Police Department and we will be glad to give you handbooks on Recreational Vehicles.

### Parents & Community Members ATV's/4 Wheelers

Over the past two months there have been three reported ATV accidents to this department. In all three reported accidents the individuals involved were under sixteen years of age. Injuries have ranged from minor to major, thus far.

The Mohawk Police recently published the Reserve By-Law pertaining to ATV's. Also, the Recreational Vehicles Handbook available from the Ministry of Transportation and Communications Police Department. Again, this is a very informational handbook, which covers vehicle registration, safety tips for off-road vehicles, collision reports & all-terrain vehicle accident statistics. Another informative handout available at the Mohawk Police Department is the Great Adventure: TIPS for the ATV rider.

We cannot stress to you as Parents and owners of All Terrain Vehicles the importance of SAFE DRIVING HABITS. Please use care and consideration when using your ATV's.
