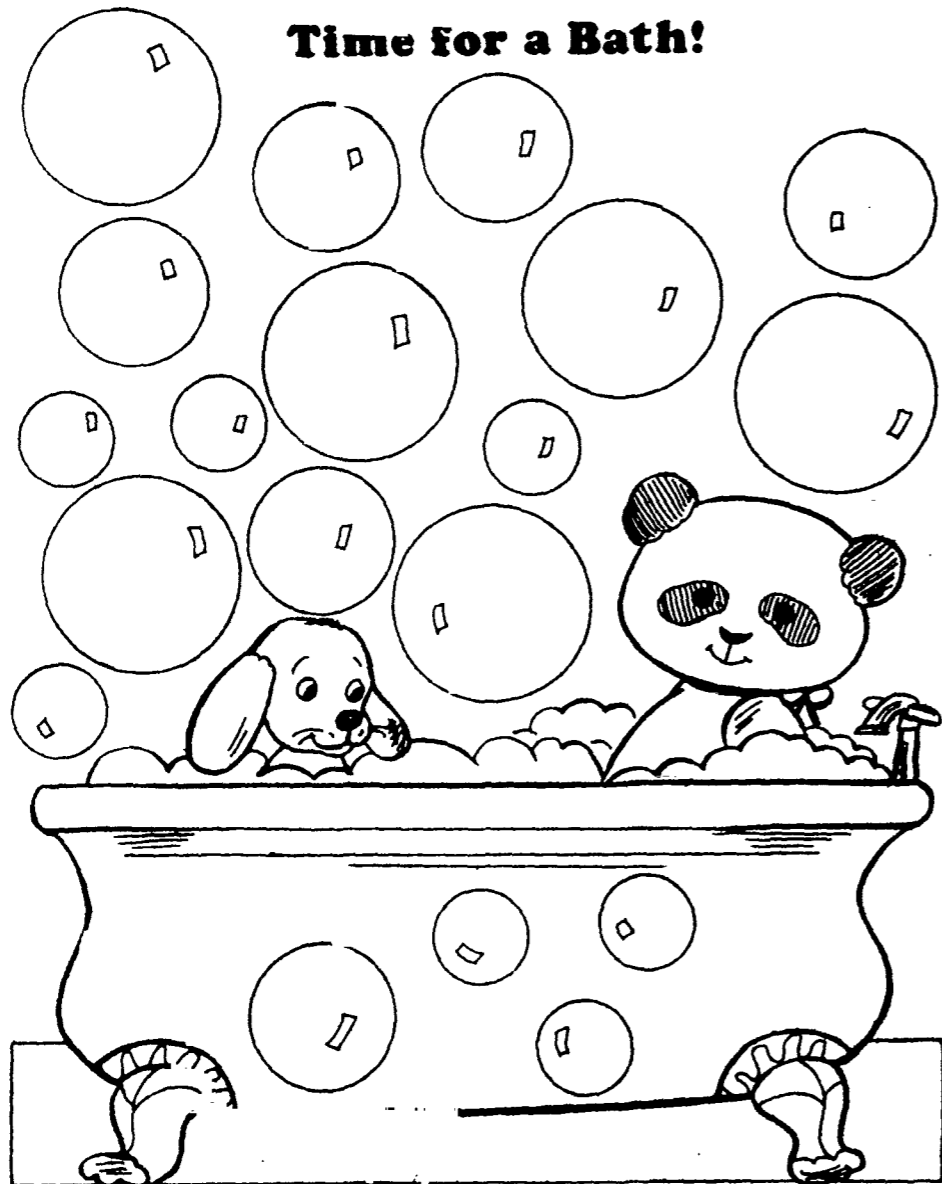


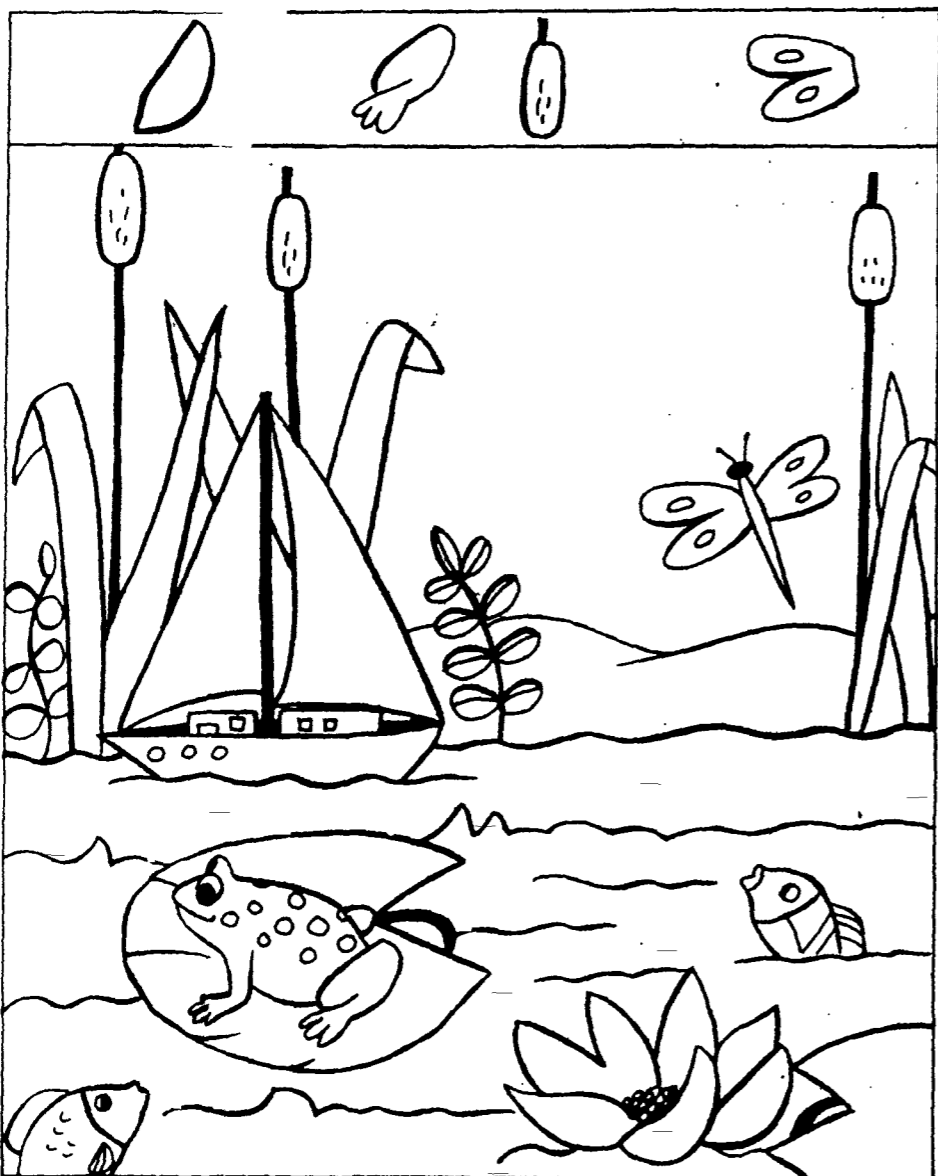

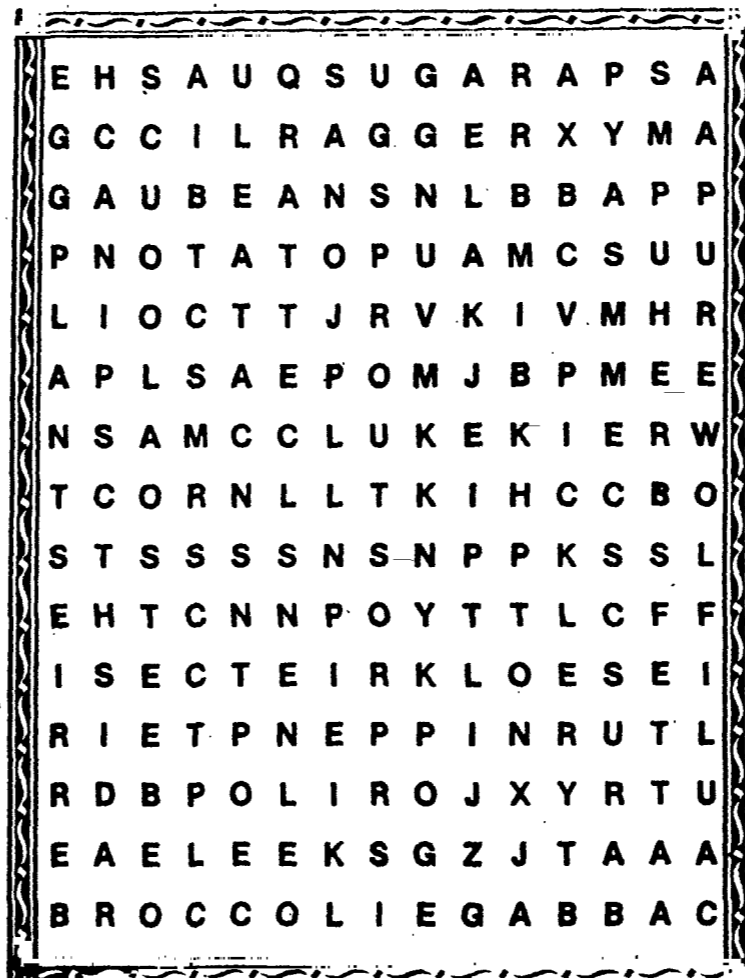
## Time for a Bath!

The shapes in the top row appear somewhere in the picture. Find the shapes, then color the picture.

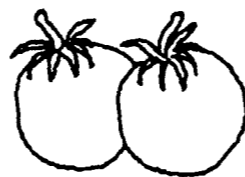

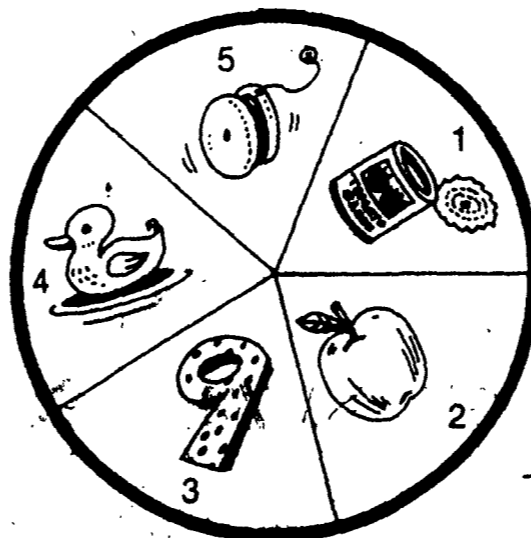

## RECYCLING

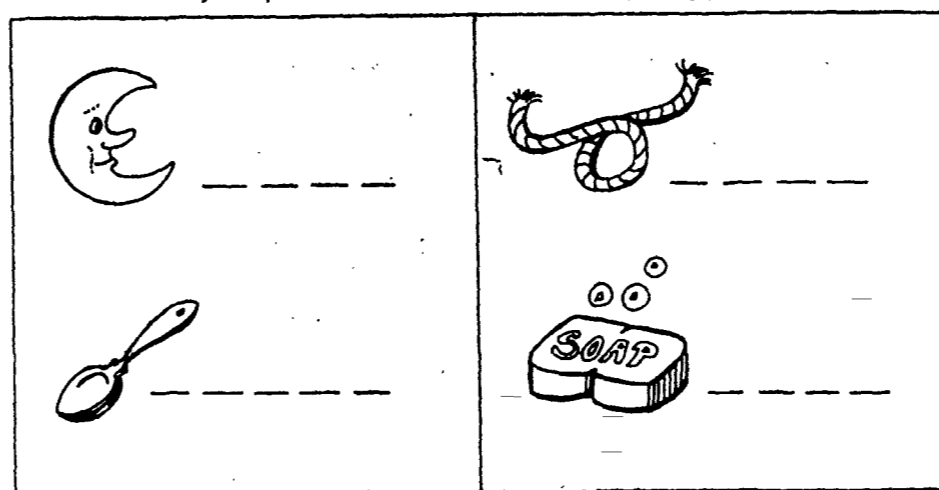
WHAT DOES RECYCLE MEAN? TO RECYCLE MEANS TO REUSE SOMETHING. FOR EXAMPLE, THIS NEWSPAPER. IT TAKES TIME TO RECYCLE BUT THERE ARE MANY GOOD REASONS WHY EVERYONE SHOULD PITCH IN: LANDFILLS OR GARBAGE DUMPS ARE CLOSING EVERY DAY. ONE DUMP HAS JUST CLOSED IN BOMBAY. THERE JUST ISN'T ANY MORE ROOM FOR TRASH. BESIDES RUNNING OUT OF ROOM, LANDFILLS ARE DANGEROUS. THEY ARE HUGE HOLES IN THE EARTH THAT ARE USED FOR DUMPING GARBAGE. WHEN GARBAGE IS DUMPED INTO THESE HOLES IT ROTS, MIXES WITH WATER AND A MIXTURE CALLED LEACHATE IS FORMED. THIS "TOXIC SOUP"—USUALLY DRAINS INTO SEWERS AND SOMETIMES INTO DRINKING WATER.

RECYCLING IS GOOD FOR YOUR PIGGY BANK TOO. WHEN YOU RECYCLE, COMPANIES THAT WE BUY FROM ARE ABLE TO BUY RECYCLED MATERIAL FOR LESS THAN NON-RECYCLED MATERIAL AND IN TURN THEY CHARGE LESS FOR THEIR PRODUCTS. RECYCLING ALSO SAVES OUR NATURAL RESOURCES, SUCH AS TREES. IF WE RECYCLE PAPER, THE DEMAND TO CUT DOWN MORE TREES WILL BE LESS. TREES ARE A VERY IMPORTANT PART OF OUR LIVES EVERY DAY. TREES MAKE THE AIR WE BREATHE CLEAN. TREES EAT BAD AIR AND IN RETURN THEY GIVE US OXYGEN. WITHOUT TREES OUR EARTH WOULD BE AN UGLY PLACE FOR BIRDS, ANIMALS AND HUMANS TO LIVE. RECYCLING CUTS DOWN ON TRASH IN OUR LANDFILLS. MAKES THE ENVIRONMENT A LOT MORE SAFE AND IT TURNS WASTE BACK IN TO USEFUL THINGS THAT WE ALL CAN USE AND IT SAVES OUR TREES.

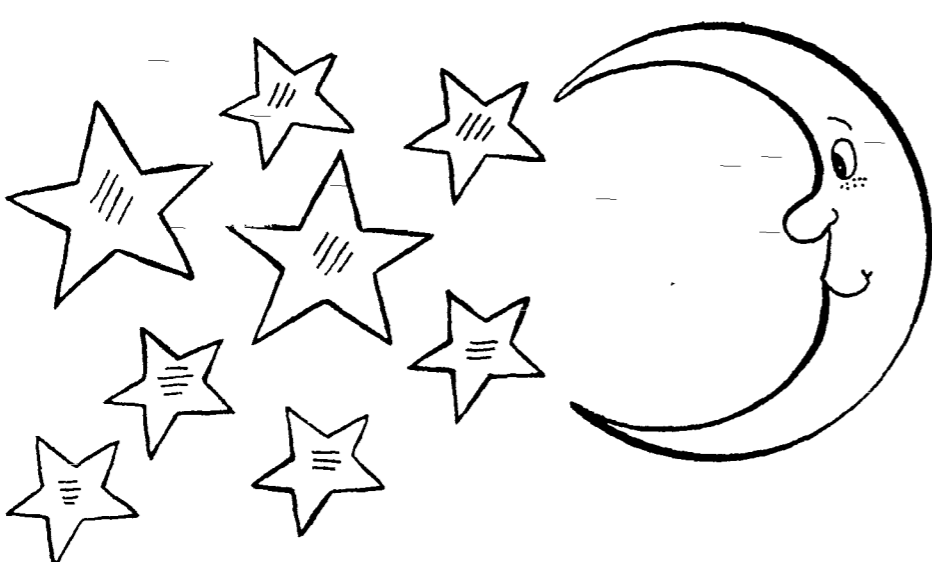
