During the end of budget negotiations, funds for Ward Stone's toxicology work at the Department of Environmental Conservation were removed and a "reappropriation" inserted with supposedly \$227,000 in unspent monies carried over from last year. Unfortunately, it only existed on paper—the money has been spent! Ward has been hard at work testing numerous hazardous dumps, oil and pesticide spills. Due to this reappropriation, he is once again left with no funds for critical toxicological testing.

You can help restore funding to the Wildlife Pathology Unit by writing Assembly Speaker Weprin, Senate Majority Leader Marino, Assemblyman Hinchey and your local senator and assemblymember. Tell them you want:

\$250,000 restored to Ward Stone's Wildlife Pathology Unit in the Legislature's proposed "cleanup" budget this session. Without it, Ward cannot investigate toxic pollution in New York State.

On Tonite, staff members and on-air personnel will be at St. Columbans Hall at 40, 4th street west in Cornwall.

Although the target audience is the teenagers, the wide variety of music can suit anyone's taste.

CKON entered into a contract with Lorne Dennison of Valley Video. He was looking to advertise his company.

His show toured all over Ontario and he got a good response from the kids.

This first show will be an experiment to see what problems need to be worked out. A remote broadcast is a possibility for future dances and this will depend on how the Friday 15th show goes.

The name Valley Video was dropped and the CKON Video Dance Tour was added.

Future ventures will be in the States and these details are being worked out with Customs.

The starting time is also in the experimental stages. Dennison usually starts his shows at 8:30, but for the benefit of air shifts and scheduling, the CKON promotions committee decided to hold it at 8:00p.m.

Things are on the move for 97.3FM.

Recently they got the rights to present the Monster Truck Show at the Cornwall Civic Complex on tonight: The same time as their inaugural teen video dance.

The CKON Crew will appear on stage with a camera set up. The job of CKON's people is to appear on camera and introduce the next few videos.

They are understandably hesitant about this.

Rene is the afternoon drive time announcer and although she is going to St. Columbans Hall, going onstage is another matter.

The consensus among staff is to decide who will go on first.

Because the programming deals with all music from the spectrum, it was decided that once the crew gets the hang of it, they should introduce the videos that reflect their musical tastes.

Bill Henry is the Saturday Night "State Of Rock" host and his music would be heavy metal and hard rock.

Assuredly Bill plans to be there. Although he hasn't participated in these video dances, he has seen them.

The common gray area of all staff is being in front of a group of people.

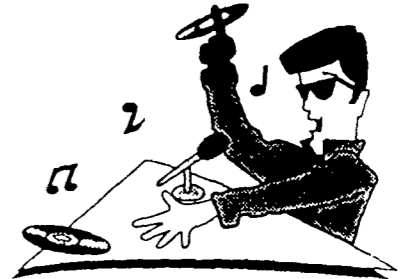
"A few years ago I was the Master of Ceremonies for a summer concert with local Cornwall bands," he adds, "I was shy but now I have overcome it to a certain extent."

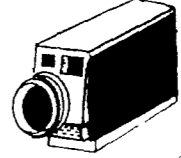

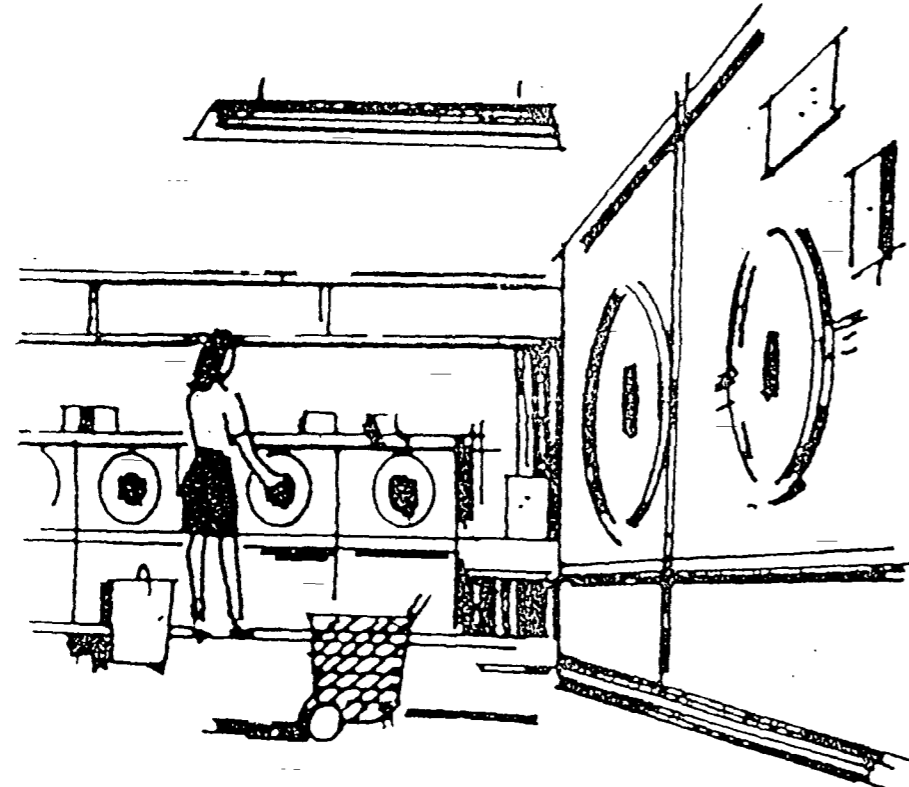
