All Candidate names nominated for the above positions will be posted within 24 hours, at the appropriate nomination district location.

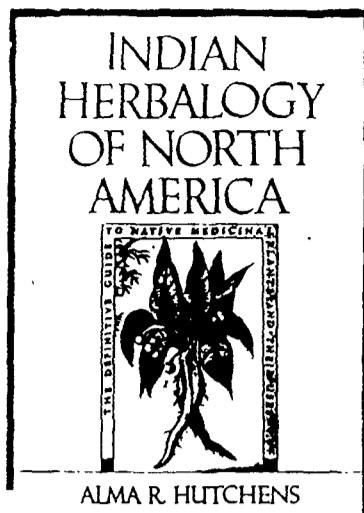
