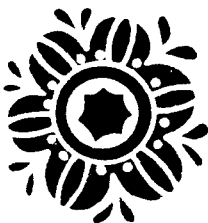
**Living Stations of the Cross:** at St. Mary's Church, Fort Covington, Sunday, April 9th at 7 pm. All are invited to attend.
