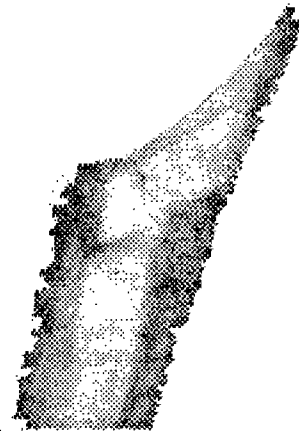


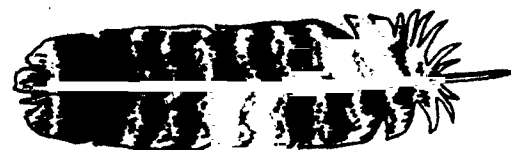
Sharla Howard from Kahnésatake was the Youth Award recipient.

- \* Women who are pregnant or nursing or postpartum.
- \* Infants from birth to 1 year old.
- \* Children from 1 up to 5 years of age.

### WIC PROVIDES:

- \* nutrition counseling and supplemental foods without charge.

### WIC IS FOR YOU

If you reside on the American side of the Reservation and If you are pregnant or breastfeeding or If you have any children under the age of five, and you fall under these income guidelines:
