The North American Indian Travelling College would like to announce to the community that we will be holding a Leather/Traditional Clothing workshop to start on May 1, 1995.

There will be registration for the workshop on Monday, April 17, 1995. Registration fee is \$20.00 American. The class is limited to 20 people. You must register on April 17 if you want to take this workshop. For those who don't pre-register on April 17, 1995, they will not be allowed to participate once the class has started. It is very important that you attend the registration and know what you want to make so the leather can be ordered. The leather must be paid for by the first class.

You can have the opportunity to make leggings, breechclothes, moccasins, medicine bags, dresses, ribbon shirts, ribbon dresses or whatever else you had in mind. Remember, you must preregister on April 17, 1995 to attend this workshop.

To all those who criticize our Typo's, try proof reading this:

Here's a puzzle for you. First read this sentence aloud:

**FINISHED FILES ARE
THE RESULT OF
YEARS OF SCIENTIF-
IC STUDY COMBINED
WITH THE EXPERI-
ENCE OF YEARS.**

Now count aloud the letter F's in the sentence. But count them *only once, Do Not go back and count them again!*

How many F's are in the sentence?

Most people say there are three. Surprisingly, there are six. How does this puzzle work? I've tried it on more than 100 people, and almost everyone missed it.

The main factor may be pronunciation. When we say the letter F aloud, we pronounce it the way we do in the word "finished." That's why the sentence is begun with a "soft" F. It leads us into linking the letter F to the soft sound, then immediately reinforces that link with another soft F in "files". This makes it easy to miss the "hard" F's in "of" that are pronounced like V's. Then the word "scientific" is broken (hyphenated) at the soft "F" again, further reinforcing that pronunciation link. And, finally, the F we missed before is repeated in the last line, coupled with the same word: years.
