Request for Proposals for Master Real Estate Developer

The Community Development Agency of West Palm Beach, Florida, is seeking proposals for the purpose of selecting a Master Real Estate Developer to lease or purchase, construct, operate and manage a large scale multi-phased, mixed-use urban development consisting of as much as 2.8 million square feet in an area of up to 65 acres in the "Downtown/Uptown" area. Each proposal will address such uses as: Residential, Retail, Office, entertainment, restaurant, governmental, museum, institutional, cultural, convention center, parking, parks and related public areas, and associated recreational amenities.
