The successful applicant will serve as direct contact for all contractors developing the Cultural and Natural Resource Damage Assessment Plans for the SRMT.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Coordinate and participate in all conference calls, meetings, and activities of the St. Lawrence Environment Trustee Council (SLETC).
- Direct work of contractors developing Cultural Assessment Plan and Natural Resource Damage Assessment Plan including review and comment of drafts.
- Organize public meetings and compile public comments.
- Direct work relayed with on-going biological, cultural and database studies.
