Mohawk Nation Longhouse  
Saturday, May 6, 2000

## Friday, May 5

Haudenosaunee will start to arrive.  
Guests will be fed lunch and supper.  
Cooks are invited to help.  
Helpers will be needed to finish siding on the Cookhouse.

## Saturday, May 6

7 - 11 am.....Breakfast served to guests, then open to the community

Noon.....Condolence starts at Noon.

.....Chiefs (only) are fed a light lunch before the ceremony

.....Younger brothers will start from Ernest David's house and proceed to towards the Longhouse. Once Chiefs and delegates are inside the Mohawk Nation Longhouse, a pot luck dinner will be for the people outside the Longhouse

Men are asked to show people where to park. There will be parking at the Longhouse parking lot, but at an adjacent area.

At the end of the condolence ceremony will be a condolence feast for Haudenosaunee.

Social to follow the condolence ceremony.
