The kids will enjoy the many craft activities available, including beading, cornhusk doll making, ceramics, and T-shirt stenciling, and all will be fascinated by the demonstration of flintknapping and other archeology displays. - Within the jurisdiction of AMBE. This would be opened to all Akwasne students who attend Canadian high schools such as G.V.S.S., C.C.V.S., St. Lawrence High, St. Joseph and Co-Op.

- Students who attend a U.S. high school can apply through the respective American high school to be accepted as part of the American Delegation.

We regret any inconvenience or misunderstanding that parents feel that we are being too restrictive to those students who attend U.S. high schools; for that we have not been asked to be a part of the U.S. delegations.
