The Lightning began the 2000 season with a great start.

On Friday April 28 at Anonwarako:wa Arena the Lightning went on to win 13-10.

The brother combination of Lance and Lucas Mitchell combined for twelve points this game. Last year they hooked up for 144 points. Lance, last years Akwesasne leading scorer netted five with two assists and Lucas scored four goals with one assist.

Also contributing in goals were Evan Cree, Kevin Smart, Nolan Thompson & Josh Jacobs. Richard Oakes and Jon Tarbell recorded three assists each.

The Lightning management decided to start the 2000 season without exhibition games and for the first game against a tough opponent, Assistant Coach Rob Cree liked what he saw.

"We still have work but we are not complaining, we moved the ball well, had lots of shots and the offense was there." The teams decision to go sans exhibition games was because of the times they meet over the year, said Cree.

"We play them 4 or 5 times, you get sick of seeing them."

One of those things the Lightning has to develop is conditioning. They have some help in that department with field lacrosse players like Evan Cree who has been playing for Salmon River.

Thompson opened up the scoring 1:56 into the first period but Kahnawake tied five seconds later with Winston Goodleaf netting his first of two.

The game went scoreless for the next nine minutes until Lance Mitchell and Smart scored 19 seconds apart. That 3-1 lead was short-lived as Louis Alfred of the Junior Mohawks scored unassisted. Alfred was sixth in league regular season scoring last year but first in penalty minutes.

The goals came in bunches as Kahnawake took over the lead with Johnathan Kane and Curtis Diabo scoring to give them the 4-3 count. Lance Mitchell scored his second of the night with 5:51 and less than a minute later the rivalry heated up.

Akwesasne's Joe Burns, Scott Thompson & Calvin Point got into a wrestling match against Travis Zachary, Angus Horne, Jake Deer and Iohare Rice. All received five minute majors with Burns receiving a ten minute misconduct.

When play continued Alfred scored his second of four on the night and Lucas Mitchell scored for the Lightning to end the first 5-5.

3:34 into the middle period Lance Mitchell completed his hat-trick and that proved to be the game winner as his team mates outscored Kahnawake 5-2.

Three of Lucas Mitchells' goals came in that span with Jacobs adding one. Alfred and Goodleaf scored for the Jr. Mohawks.

That second period saw the Lightning take 20 minutes in the penalty box and the visitors 16.

The third period was more subdued as each team scored three. Lance Mitchell (2) and Cree for the Lightning and Alfred, Mitchell Horne and Jamie Norton countered for Kahnawake.

Coach Rob Cree said the his line-up is not finished yet as some players are in school. 53 point man Raweras Mitchell is away and Casey Swamp and Daryl Seymour will join the team later.

One area the club needed to address was
