Furnish a little table with writing materials to hostess. Be sure the wardrobe and chest of drawers are empty, so that she may unpack and arrange her dresses at ease.

When the guest arrives have the luggage taken at once to her room, and when she goes upstairs send a servant to unpack her boxes and take her to her room.

Every morning you should visit your guest's room and see that the chambermaid has put in the most orderly and comfortable arrangement for the day.

Entertain her nicely, even at some intervals, if you have any favorite articles of food and have the dishes prepared.

Forbid the children to go into the visitor's room unless with a message.

When the guest leaves see the servant goes up to strap her boxes and bring them down. If she leaves by an early train some of the family must be present to see that the trunk is packed and taken to the luggage.
