FARMERS' INSTITUTE.

Caucus Cut Down Attendance at the Afternoon Session.

The various caucuses which were held Saturday afternoon interfered somewhat with the attendance at the Farmers' Institute, which was in session in Grange hall.

William Hotelling of Kinderhook, opened the morning session with a brief statement of the purposes of the meeting. Lime and fertilizers and their constituents were discussed by Mr. Witter. C. S. Phelps of Canton, Superintendent of the County Farm Bureau, spoke on various means of improving the soil.

The benefit of cow testing associations in improving dairymen's conditions was the subject of an address by Mr. Witter in the afternoon.

Mr. Hotelling talked on the most advantageous leguminous plants to grow. There was also a special woman's session in the afternoon in charge of Mrs. D. A. Jones of Worcester. It was very largely attended.

The speeches in the evening covered the farm and its buildings. Mr. Hotelling spoke on "Improving the Home Grounds," and Mrs. Jones talked on "Sanitation, Heating and Ventilation."
