

CONFERENCE TO BE HELD AT MALONE

ANNUAL GATHERING OF THE METHODIST CHURCH THERE IN APRIL.

The annual session of Northern New York Conference of the Methodist Church meets in Malone April 13, and will be attended by over 200 ministers and a lay delegate from each charge. Bishop Burt of Buffalo will preside. Both ministerial and lay delegates will be elected to attend the General Conference to be held at Des Moines, Iowa, in May. Friday, April 16, will be Laymen's Day. The Laymen's Association will have a meeting for business at the Baptist church and in the evening will have a banquet at the chapel of the Congregational church, to be addressed by Bishop Burt and by others. Bishop Burt will probably give the conference lecture the same evening after the banquet. Bishop Burt is in "Flight" and Germany.

The conference will be of unusual interest on account of the great Centenary program. Many leading churchmen will be heard. The clergy will be entertained at Malone homes, irrespective of denomination and affiliations, for lodgings and for breakfasts only, taking their dinners and suppers elsewhere.

HOUSE BOAT BURNED.

The houseboat Winona owned by J. H. Brown of Alexandria Bay was totally destroyed by fire last week. The boat was valued at \$5,000 and the insurance is about \$2,000. The fire is believed to have started from stoves used in heating the vessel, which was being repainted and otherwise put in condition for the season's service.

TO PLANT 100,000 TREES.

Carthage Plans To Reforest Land On Its Watershed.

The Carthage board of water commissioners is planning on making some important improvements during the coming year at the head of the water supply system. An order has been placed for 100,000 acres, comprising spruce, white pine and red pine which will all be planted the coming summer.

Thousands of pine trees planted on the tract during the last ten years are now becoming valuable, many of them having grown to a height of 19 feet. It will be a matter of only a few years when the village of Carthage will have a growth of pine timbers that will be valuable and worth thousands of dollars.

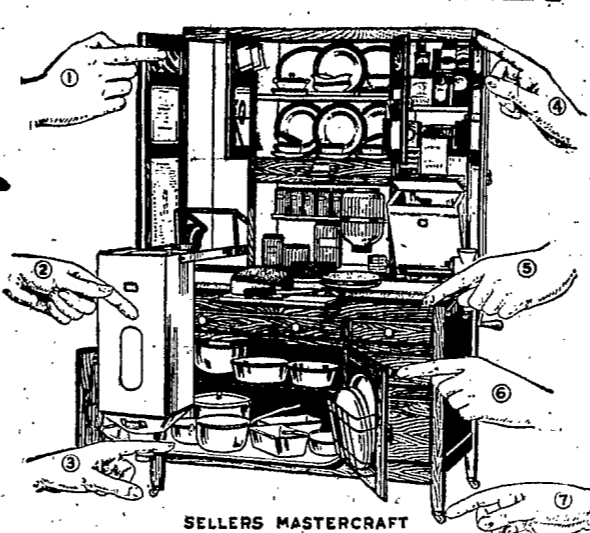
WAARDEN TROMBLY DEAD.
