NORWOOD REPORTS SEVERAL DEATHS

SERVICES FOR N. E. PEARSON LOUIS HAND AND MRS. WALKER

Norwood, March 15.—Noah Pearson died at his home in Spring street Monday after a few week illness. He was born in New York September 15, 1839, and came to Norwood in 1857, where he has since lived and followed the business of painter and decorator until a few years ago when his health began to fail. He is survived by his wife and one son, Arthur, of Winthrop, also four grandchildren. The funeral was held at the house Wednesday afternoon, the Rev. Joseph Phillips officiating.

C. railroad for the past 27 years acting as train baggage man. The funeral was held at the home Wednesday afternoon, the Rev. Carter officiating.

ORDERS LOCK-UP CLOSED

Prison Commission Frowns On Norwood's Calaboose

Norwood, March 15.—The New York State Prison Commission, at a meeting in Albany last week ordered the lockup in Norwood closed within 90 days. The action follows various reports which have been made to the commission by Miss H. Pierce, of Gouverneur, and which really date back for a considerable period of time.

While the village trustees on January 30, passed a resolution that the lockup be closed, yesterday's action on the part of the state prison commission not only makes it a misdemeanor should the village attempt to reopen the lockup or use it even for a single person under arrest, but also makes it imperative upon Norwood, should it later decide to build a lockup, to have its plans approved by the state commission.
