

Hold Last Rites For Fred McGill

Last rites for Fred L. McGill, 73, a printer more than half a century, were held yesterday, Jan. 24. Mr. McGill died at his 7 Hamilton St. home early Monday morning of a heart attack.

He had been downtown Saturday and seemed in good health. He suffered an attack early Sunday and later suffered a more severe attack that proved fatal.

Mr. McGill was born in Norwood on Nov. 3, 1877, a son of Robert and Elizabeth Laney McGill. After attending school in Norwood he became an apprentice printer at the Norwood News and later worked in Haddon.

He joined the *Potomac Herald* as a printer and pressman in 1902 and continued at that post until his retirement last June.

He was married to Miss Blanche Bearden of Massena on Nov. 23, 1903. They have lived in Potomac ever since. Mr. McGill was active in Methodist Church affairs.

Surviving, besides his wife, are a son, Robert John McGill, a Clarkson professor and a sister, Mrs. James Bain.

A prayer service was held yesterday at the home, followed by rites at the Methodist Church at 2. The Rev. Wendell R. Carter officiated. Interment was at Riverside Cemetery, Norwood.

Bearers were W. J. Revett, Walter Sanford, Fay MacDonald, Sanford Dewey, George Bulles and Arthur J. West.
