The Lenten season begins with Ash Wednesday, Feb. 7th. The growth of a penitential preparation for Easter from a single day in the second century to nine full weeks (including pre-Lent) in the eighth century is revelatory of the changes of the ethos of Christian worship from joy in redemption to fear of penitence. But since the Reformation a counter-change, in practice if not in the liturgy, has taken place in the Church, by a radical relaxation of the Lenten rules. The Church has found that the mediaeval rigorous Lenten rules were a mistake.
 Lent is generally viewed today as a season of special spiritual opportunity, rather than as a penitential period in the older sense.
