The award given entitles her to compete with other students from the state and nation for the national award. All contestants must prepare an essay entitled "A Republic If You Can Keep It."

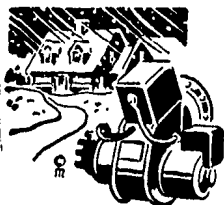
DAR WILL MEET

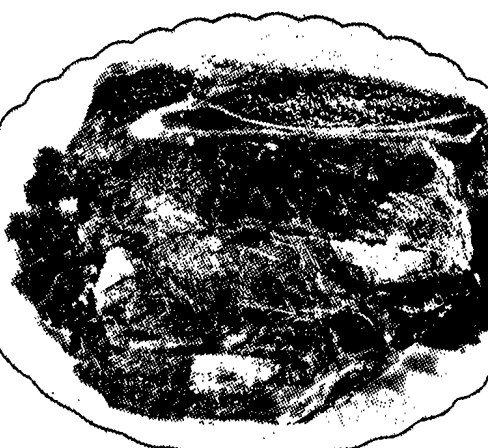
