Funeral services for Nellie J. Young, 94, widow of Henry Young and one of Potsdam's oldest residents, were held Saturday, Jan. 19, at 9 a. m. at the Garner Funeral Home and at 9:30 from St. Mary's Catholic Church. Burial will be in St. Mary's cemetery.

Mrs. Young died Wednesday night at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Earle Arton, with whom she had lived. She had been in failing health.

She was born in Potsdam June 15, 1868, a daughter of Fred and Julia LeGeau LaLonde. She was married to Henry Young and the couple always lived in Potsdam where Mr. Young was employed with the St. Lawrence division of the New York Central railroad. He died in 1939.

Since the death of her husband, Mrs. Young had made her home with her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Arton. She was a member of St. Mary's Church.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. Earl (Geraldine) Arton, 15 Waverly street, two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Mr. Amo died Saturday morning at his home from a self-inflicted gunshot wound. Police list the cause of death as "by his own hand," suicide.

Born in Potsdam Sept. 21, 1902 he was a son of Frank and Nettie Cota Amo. He lived in Potsdam all his life and attended local schools.

He married the former Mabel Martin and the couple lived in the area all of their married life. She died in March of 1962. Mr. Amo had been an employee of Nekoosa-Edwards Paper Co. for the past 10 years.

Burial will be made in the family plot at Bayside Cemetery in the Spring.
