## Boating Safety Course Offered

Area youngsters interested in  
taking New York State's new  
Young Boatman's Safety Course  
may enroll now for the course  
according to Sgt. Al Fuchs Sr.  
who has volunteered to teach  
the program in this area.

Posters, on which young  
sailors may enroll for the  
course, have been placed at the  
following locations: Potsdam  
Central, Lawrence Avenue  
School, St. Mary's School, Con-  
don Campus School, Colton-  
Pierpont Central, Norwood-  
Norfolk Central and Parishville  
Hopkinton Central Schools.  
Youngsters between the ages

of 10-14 must take the course,  
sponsored by the Conservation  
Department's Division of Motor  
Boats, and earn a safety certi-  
ficate before they may lawfully  
operate a mechanically prop-  
elled boat alone on New York  
State waters this year.

Fuchs urges area youngsters  
to enroll now for the course so  
that they will not be disappoint-  
ed when the boating season gets  
into full swing this summer.

The course consists of eight  
basic units and is designed to  
be taught in half-hour sessions.  
All course material will be fur-  
nished free to youngsters taking  
the course.

Plan books, work books and  
flip charts, all graphically il-  
lustrating basic safety require-  
ments and precautions, will be  
used in teaching the course.  
The charts will be based on a  
boating safety handbook titled  
"Make Sure—Make Shore."

The course is being taught in  
this area in the Potsdam Central
