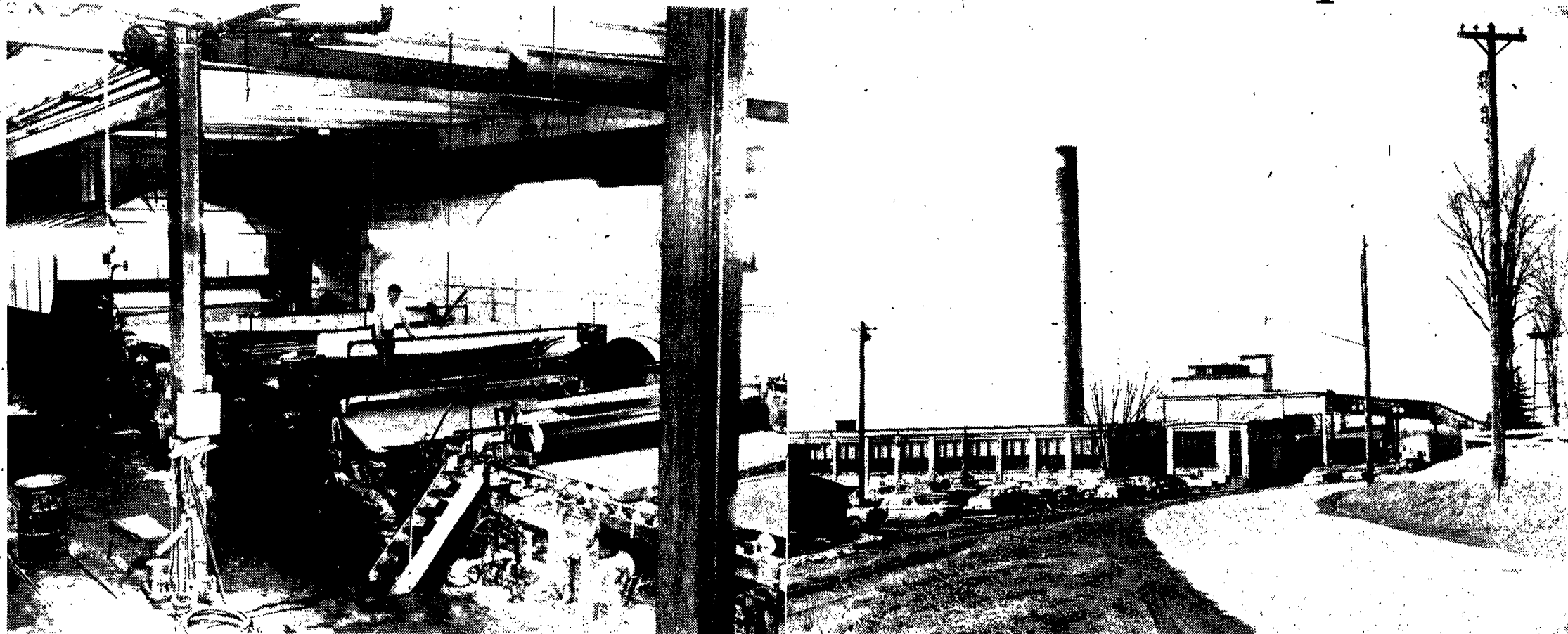


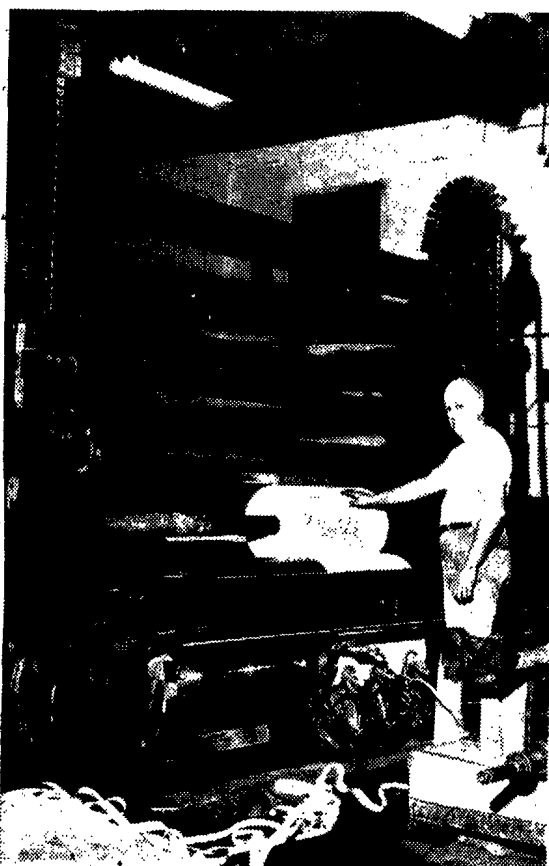
St. Lawrence Pulp & Paper Corp. In Full Operation



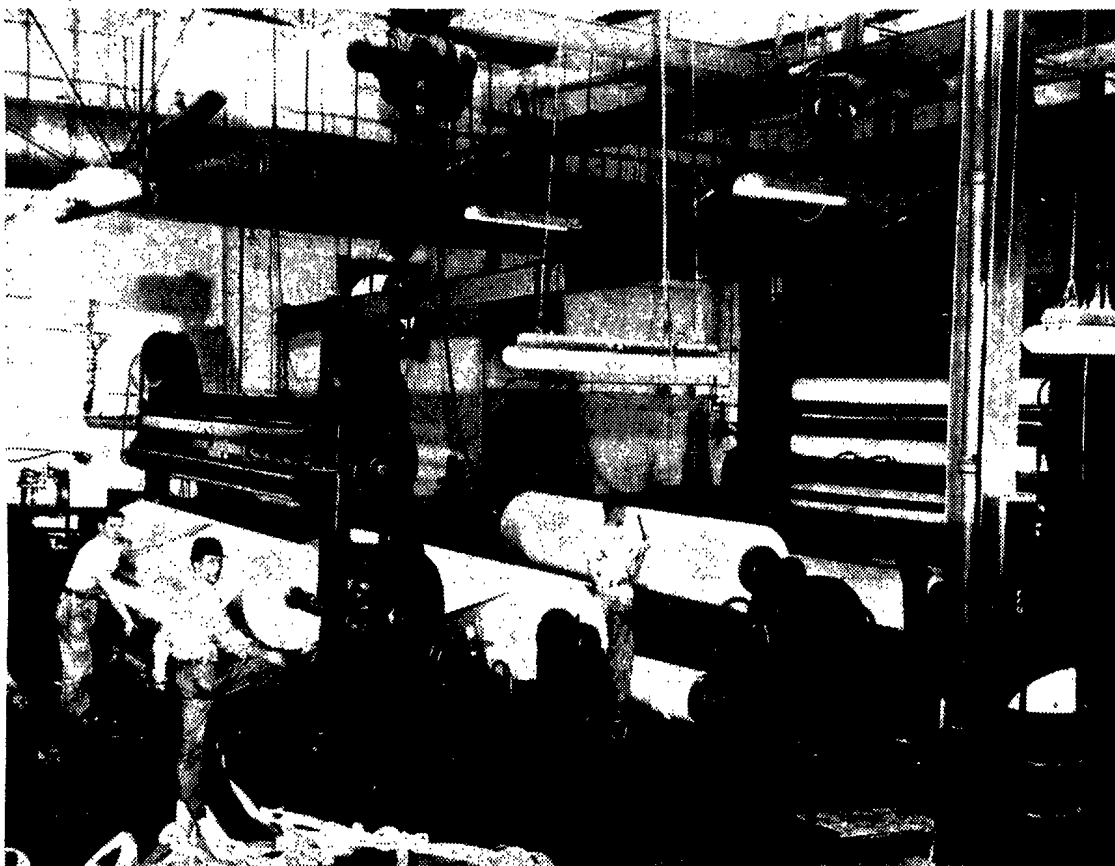

Another operation of the Norfolk mill is shown in the above photo.

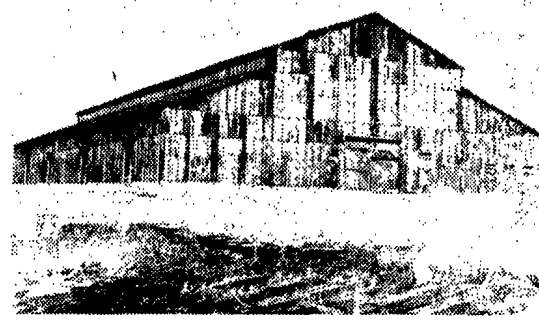


The Dry End or finish product is being rolled on Machine Two at the Norfolk Mill. Pictured are Winderman Junior

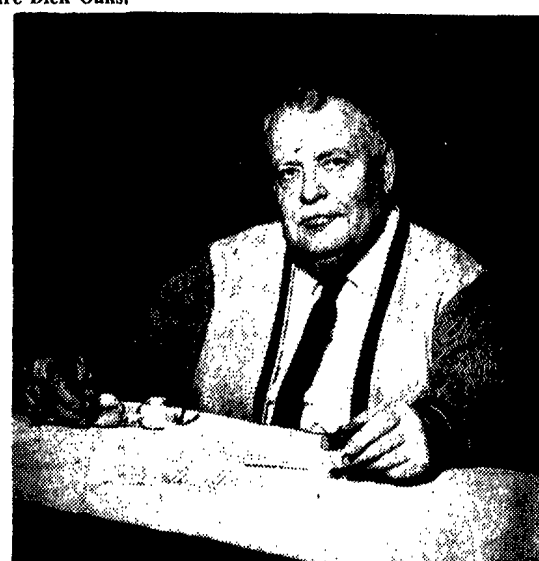
