

necticut 1879 anti-birth control law which prohibited the use of contraceptives and the distribution of information about their use. Senator Ernest Gruening (D. Alaska) has a bill apparently with a good chance to be approved because it would not legislate any federal population control criteria but would only provide for the gathering and dissemination of information on birth control.
Outside the Congress, former Senator Kenneth Keating (R. N.Y.), chairman of the new Population Crisis Committee, reports "the current explosive growth of population threatens the success of the Alliance for Progress, the war-on-poverty, foreign aid and innumerable domestic problems to which the Congress has committed billions of dollars."
Milk production on New York farms last year totaled 10,914 million pounds, about one per cent more than in 1963.
