## NY State gains 16 Landing Facilities

New York State gained 16 landing facilities in 1965 for a total of 367 airports, seaplane bases and heliports, according to the 1966 New York State Airport Map and Directory issued by the State Commerce Department.

The 29 by 32 inch map, printed in eight colors, is designed as a handy guide for the State's pilots and the aviation industry. All aviation airports, seaplane bases and heliports are listed with their radio frequencies, locations and identification codes.

The directory covers data on field elevations and a complete listing of general aviation services, including instruction, charter, aircraft sales, crop dusting, rentals, soaring, aerial photography and scheduled air taxi.

Other features of the map include land elevations, principal waterways, major highways, the Thruway, railroads, the State Barge Canal System, State Parks and the population of cities and towns. More than 500 communities and 54 Thruway interchanges are underlined in red. These have been earmarked by the State Commerce Department as aids to navigation.

Thirty-three new facilities were opened in the State during the past year, while 17 suspended operations, bringing the total to 367. New landing facilities listed include:

- Non-commercial airports — DeGrasse, Elbridge, Hancock, Knowlesville, Laweville, Schron Lake and Union Springs;
- Commercial airports — Geneva, Millbrook, Monticello and Riverhead; Flying Farmer landing facilities — Castleton-on-the-Hudson, Macedon and Victory; Personal use airports — Beekmantown, Canandaigua, DeGrasse, Dundee, East Berne, Hilton, Homer, Indian Lake, LaFargeville, Middlesex, Rome and Yulan; Heliports — Buffalo (3), Far Rockaway and Niagara Falls; Seaplane bases — Monticello and Rochester.

Fifty-three municipal, eight military and 251 private airports are listed in the directory according to ownership. Facilities classified according to use include 21 airline airports, 90 commercial, 89 non-commercial, 87 personal use, 17 Flying Farmer, eight military, 31 seaplane bases and 24 heliports.

Airports in adjacent states and Canada, as well as airports of entry to and exit from Canada are shown. The map has a special inset delineating airport facilities in the New York Metropolitan Area and on Long Island.

On the directory side are alphabetical lists of heliports, by community, and airports and seaplane bases, both by community and facility name, fixed base operators and their telephone numbers, and names of scheduled certificated airlines serving each carrier airport. Mailing addresses and other useful information are included.

The State Commerce Department's Bureau of Aviation urges all airport operators to place copies of the new map in the glove compartments of all planes and on airport bulletin boards. If any needed corrections or additions are noted, it is requested that they so notify the Bureau of Aviation.

A free supply of "New York State Airport Map and Directory, 1966" will be mailed to all landing facilities in the State, with additional copies available free to airport and other aviation interests from the State Commerce Department upon request.

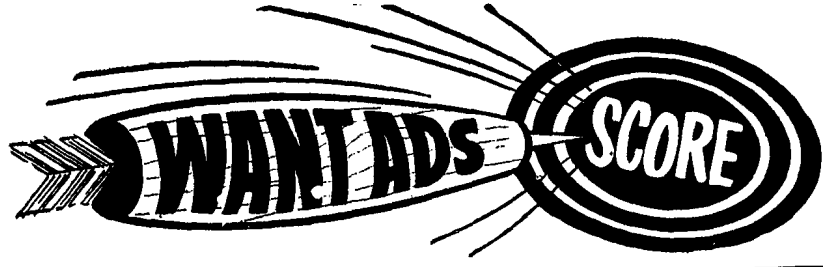
