

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Town Board of the Town of Stockholm, St. Lawrence County, New York, has scheduled a public hearing for September 9, 1976 at 7:30 p.m. at the Town Hall, Stockholm, New York, to consider certain amendments to the cable television franchise previously granted to New Channels Corporation. The purpose of the hearing is to consider the adoption of amendments which will (a) bring the franchise into conformity with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by the New York State Commission on Cable Television and by the Federal Communications Commission, and (b) authorize a proposed amended rate schedule. The amendments, if approved by the Town of Stockholm, should not take effect without the prior approval of the New York State Commission on Cable Television. Interested parties may file comments or objections with the New York State Commission on Cable Television, Tower Building, Empire State Plaza, Albany, New York 12223. The proposed amendments, among others, include the following:

- Inclusion of a provision requiring the franchisee to use materials of good and durable quality and to perform all work involved in construction, installation, and repair of the cable system in a safe, thorough and reliable manner.
- Inclusion of a provision prohibiting abandonment of the franchise without the written consent of the Town.
- A provision stating that the franchisee will not discriminate in hiring any person because of age, race, creed, color, national origin or sex.
- A provision designating a municipal officer who will be responsible for the continuing administration of the franchise.
- A provision requiring that the terms of the franchise are subject to approval of the New York State Commission on Cable Television.
- A provision requiring the franchisee to file requests for all necessary operating authorizations with the Federal Communications Commission and the New York State Commission on Cable Television within sixty days from the date the franchise is awarded or extended.
- A provision requiring incorporation into the franchise within one year any modification of Federal or New York State standards.
- An amendment to Sections 11 and 15 of the franchise to provide for rates and charges not to exceed the following schedule:
  - Installation charge (additional outlets): \$5.00, plus cost of labor and materials, plus 15 percent.
  - Installation charge (additional outlets): \$5.00, plus cost of labor and materials, plus 15 percent.
  - Multi-Unit Commercial Customers (Hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes)
    - Installation charge (first set)-\$20.00, plus cost of labor and materials, plus 15 percent.

    - Monthly service charge for first set or FM receiver-\$9.50.
