



**DETERGENT PROPERTIES ANALYZED IN CLARKSON NSF PROJECT**-Bruce Watkins adjusts a nuclear magnetic resonance spectrometer in the chemistry lab at Clarkson College. He is involved in a summer research project at the College, funded by a National Science Foundation (NSF) grant. He is experimenting with micelles, complex charged particles which give dissolving properties to solutions such as soaps and detergents. He is studying how micelles speed up reactions in solutions and relating his work to the study of the mechanisms of enzymes. Such experiments may lead to the improvement of soap and detergent products.

**UPSET endorsed**

UPSET, Inc. has received an endorsement from NYPIRG (New York Public Interest Research Group), a statewide, non-partisan, non-profit environmental and consumer protection group with head offices in Albany. During the last legislative session NYPIRG worked on the "Nuclear Responsibility Act" introduced by North Country Assemblyman Dan Haley. The Bill requires that nuclear facilities meet reasonable safety standards before being built in New York State. NYPIRG spokesperson Betsy Johnson said, "It's hard to believe that our utility companies are intent upon building nuclear power plants in the light of the recent U.S. Geological Services report finding that there is less than a ten year proven supply of domestic uranium."
