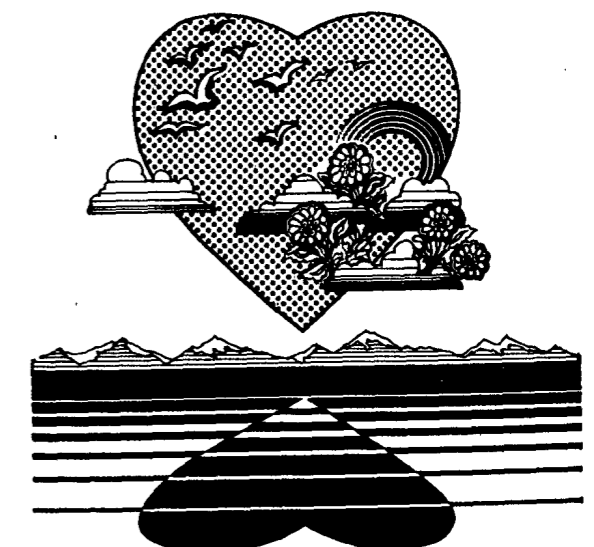
## Cancer drive makes \$87,500
