Stockholm Gets Shoreline Permit

STOCKHOLM—The Town of Stockholm has received a permit to place rock along the West Branch of the St. Regis River in Sanfordville in order to control shoreline erosion. The protection of waters permit was issued by the state Department of Environmental Conservation.

Beware Bogus Calls

ALBANY—The State Department of Taxation and Finance has warned taxpayers to disregard telephone calls from a "Mrs. Russo" who claims to work for the department.

Department officials explained that someone who identifies herself alternately as "Mrs. Russo", "Ms. Russo", or "Connie Russo" has been calling taxpayers and informing them that she has refund checks which were returned to her as undeliverable by the post office. In some instances, she has asked taxpayers to provide her with the name of their bank and account number so that she can deposit the allegedly undeliverable refund check directly into their account.

Taxpayers who asked "Mrs. Russo" for her telephone number have been told to call 474-9870. Dialing this number results in a persistent busy signal, and it has been learned that 474-8870 is actually a telephone company testing number. Although the Tax Department employs several women by the name of Russo, they are not in any way connected with these calls.

The matter is under investigation by the criminal investigation unit of the New York State Capitol Police.

Faces Charges

MASSENA—A Norfolk man was arrested by Massena State Police Friday for driving while intoxicated and desertion from the U.S. Army.

Troopers said Phillip J. McComber, 23, was arraigned in Norfolk Town Court, pleaded guilty to the DWI charge and was remanded to the custody of Air Police at Plattsburgh Air Force Base.

In a separate incident, charges are pending against Charles A. Cruikshank of Massena in connection with an accident at 9:30 p.m. Friday along Rt. 420 in the Town of Norfolk.

Troopers said Cruikshank's auto allegedly struck a parked car owned by Peter Hill of Massena. Cruikshank was taken to Massena Memorial Hospital, treated for chest pains and released.
