Taxpayers Get Break On Property Sales

ALBANY — A relatively new tax law allows taxpayers who have sold property after Oct. 31, 1978 to keep an extra ten percent of the gain, the Internal Revenue Service said.

The Revenue Act of 1978 has increased the exclusion for long-term capital gains to 60 percent on all sales or exchanges on or before this date still get the old 50 percent exclusion. The 60 percent deduction also applies to installment payments received on or after Nov. 1, 1978.
