PIERREPONT — Again this year, the lawn of the Pierrepont Church will have a lighted Memory Tree through the Holiday Season.

Last year, the tree was lit as the fulfillment of a goal and dream of the recently deceased Ruth Clark. It was she who had planned to plant a tree in

memory of her sister, Grace Pemberton, and ask her friends and neighbors to light memorial bulbs at Christmas time.

Two trees were planted and dedicated on "Back to Pierrepont Weekend 1980." Unfortunately, for them, they were so magnificently lit

that they died. The evergreen was replaced. However, it is small, so not wanting to repeat the mistake of last year, a large temporary one will be set up.

In 1980, nearly 200 individuals were memorialized, some several times. Contributions beyond the memorial light names were also given.

Pierrepont seems to have no very suitable place to post items, so a scrapbook, starting with 1980 is being compiled. It contains items of historical interest concerning the Church. In it is a list of donors and the names of those memorialized. This is kept in the museum so that it may be available to the public.

Hazel Tupper, Box 161, Rt. 4, Canton, N.Y. 13617, will again accept donations of \$1 for each bulb you would like lighted.

As in 1980, the Historical Society will sponsor a Christmas type covered dish dinner on Dec. 6 at 5:30. Rev. David Van Epps, Pierrepont, will conduct a Christmas Season service and light the tree when those attending pause by it for prayer as they disperse.

This will be the last church-related activity for 1981. For those who cannot attend Dec. 6, the residents of Pierrepont wish you a happy and blessed holiday and future.

Winter Parking Rules In Norwood

NORWOOD — With the snow of winter approaching, the Village of Norwood has instituted new parking regulations:

"No motor vehicle shall be parked on any street within the corporate Village of Norwood, between the hours of 1 a.m. and 7 a.m. from Dec. 1, 1981 to Apr. 30, 1982. Any motor vehicle found parked on any street during the above stated times and dates, when such vehicle interferes with snow removal, the vehicle may be removed from the street at the owner's expense. Also the owner will receive an all-night parking summons."

'Mysterious' Water Contamination Plaguing Some Wells In Norfolk

NORFOLK — Several households on the Brouse Road in this township have been without drinking water lately, one for over five months, because water from their wells has been found to be unsatisfactory. And officials who are looking into it have so far been baffled.

"It's a problem that's kind of mysterious," said Norfolk Town Councilman James Belgarde last week.

Belgarde got the case after a recent Norfolk Council meeting, when one of the homeowners, Pat McCaffrey, brought the problem to the board's attention.

The councilman said that Health Officer Dr. Samuel Livingston has been alerted and has taken he matter up with Hans Paller, director of the state Health Department's subdistrict office in Massena.

But so far, no one seems to know what is causing the problem in the families' private wells.

What is known is that laboratory samples analyzed for the McCaffreys at Massena Memorial Hospital turned up a coliform count so high that it couldn't be counted, according to Mrs. Pat McCaffrey.

Contacted at her home last week, she said that her family has been transporting their drinking water from elsewhere ever since getting that report in early June.

The McCaffreys had their well tested four years ago when they moved into their house and received a good report at the time. But this summer, she said, the family noticed that "more and more it tasted funny." She said she believes the well was drilled when the house was built about 18-20 years ago.


