The team will depend heavily on the senior members of the team and much of its success will hinge on how quickly the team matures and gains confidence.

Coach LaGrand said that they have the potential to be successful, but it will take hard work, especially in the defensive phase of the game. "We lack a strong offensive threat, but our quickness and defensive ability should help to make us competitive," LaGrand said.

Manske Manhandles Tournament Foes As 'Stoners' Win Boosters Championship

 Scott Manske scored 41 points with dominant inside play to lead Potsdam to the Boosters Tournament championship last Tuesday and Wednesday nights delighting an enthusiastic home contingent.

The big forward tallied 28 points in the title game against St. Lawrence Central in what head coach Steve Kmack called, "Scott's finest outing of the season."

But the tourney's MVP received lots of help from teammates Mark Nunge and Brian Dempsey, also all-tournament selections.

Battling the flu, Nunge amassed 21 points in just 19 minutes to lead the Stoners to a 71-59 triumph over St. Regis Falls in the opening round. The 6' 6" center failed to score in the championship game, but Manske picked up the pace.

Dempsey sank 25 points over the two games and contributed fine passing and leadership. "He pushed the ball up the court and hit the open man on the break better than he has all season," said Kmack. "He's developing every game, and this was his best all-around performance."

Tupper Lake visits Potsdam Jan. 3 as the Stoners return to conference action.

"They are big inside, have probably the deepest bench in the NAC, and will have their outstanding point guard, Tim Dennis, back in action," said Kmack. "If we play smart, we'll be in the game."

Stoners Race Past Saints
 Using early pressure and forcing turnovers, Potsdam opened up a 23-point lead in the first half on their way to a 71-59 victory over St. Regis Falls. Manske and Dempsey backed up Nunge's totals with 13 points apiece for the Stoners, and Kevin Clafey added 10.

Mike Seevy was high man for St. Regis Falls with 21 points, while Scott Henderson racked up 20.

Mixed Defenses Work
 Using a hodgepodge of zones, presses, and man-to-man defenses, Potsdam forced St. Lawrence turnovers to win 76-49 in the title game.

"I was pleased with everyone's outing," said Kmack. "We ran well and scored lots of fast break layups."

Manske was on the receiving end of many of those hoops on the way to his 28-point performance. Dempsey and Mike Fields contributed 12 points each

for the Potsdam cause, and Chris Hall paced the losers with 15.

The scheduled consolation game between St. Regis Falls and Parishville-Hopkinton was cancelled because of the weather.

Hall Leads SLC Past Panthers
 In the other opening round contest, Chris Hall netted 10 of his game-high 29 points in the fourth quarter to send the game into overtime and lift the Larries over P-H 69-61.

Hall's jumper with five seconds left in regulation time tied the score at 57-57, then teammate Al Tower tallied four overtime points to help the Larries. Tower finished with 22, while the Panthers were led by Dan Fullerton's 16.

Hall and SRF's Mike Seevy were also named to the all-tournament team.
