

# Parishville And Hopkinton News And Notes

From Lake Ozonia to the Gilbert farm on Rt. 72, Parishville and Hopkinton are blanketed in snow.

A hard crust with half an inch of new powder makes snowmobiling excellent, but as for cross country skiing, I'd rather the temperature was in the 30s. Not a bit of wax has touched my wooden Norwegian skis, but I'm hoping the weather warms up soon.

Halfway between Parishville and Hopkinton on Rt. 72 is a stretch of road with no electricity available to it. Here stands a lonely stone house, its

two-foot walls keeping out the snow and rain.

The well, with its old hand pump, stands outside the kitchen, dry now, as it was every summer during the Depression years when Charlie and Goldie LaBar farmed it. Goldie says it wasn't easy, especially when she had to draw water from the spring to do the wash. They owned a gasoline-powered wringer washer which was started by pulling a cord, similar to a lawn mower.

They also used oil lamps at night. Canning was done on the two wood stoves and maple syrup used when the sugar was scarce. A pantry off the kit-

chen was full of canned meat, chicken, vegetables and fruit. According to Goldie they had a fine root cellar for the more hardy vegetables. They drove to town in a Chevrolet to buy products they couldn't raise and were mighty glad to have meat because it was so scarce.

They farmed the place for 15 years, then sold out to Cecil Hotaling. He cut the timber on the 150 acres and rented the house for a short period of time. The house changed hands again when Ithiel and Florence Grump bought it in 1957. There was good fishing and hunting for Ithiel and the boys, which they enjoyed on the weekends when they

stayed there. Lacking for the girls, at any rate, was a radio for the tunes of the day. According to Florence, Ni-Mo wanted \$5,000 to bring electric wires and poles up the Green Road in the 60s.

So Florence and her husband abandoned the idea of moving there and eventually Florence sold the house to a sister who lives in Rensselaer Falls. The back wall of the house is deteriorating and the stones have become loose. Hopefully this part of history will not crumble away. It reminds us of the days when families worked together as a team to survive the elements. Days before radio,

telephone and blaring music. Sounds good — hook up the horses and maybe I'll give it a go.

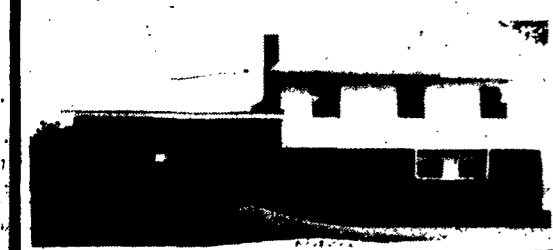

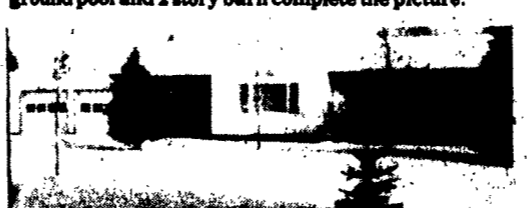
