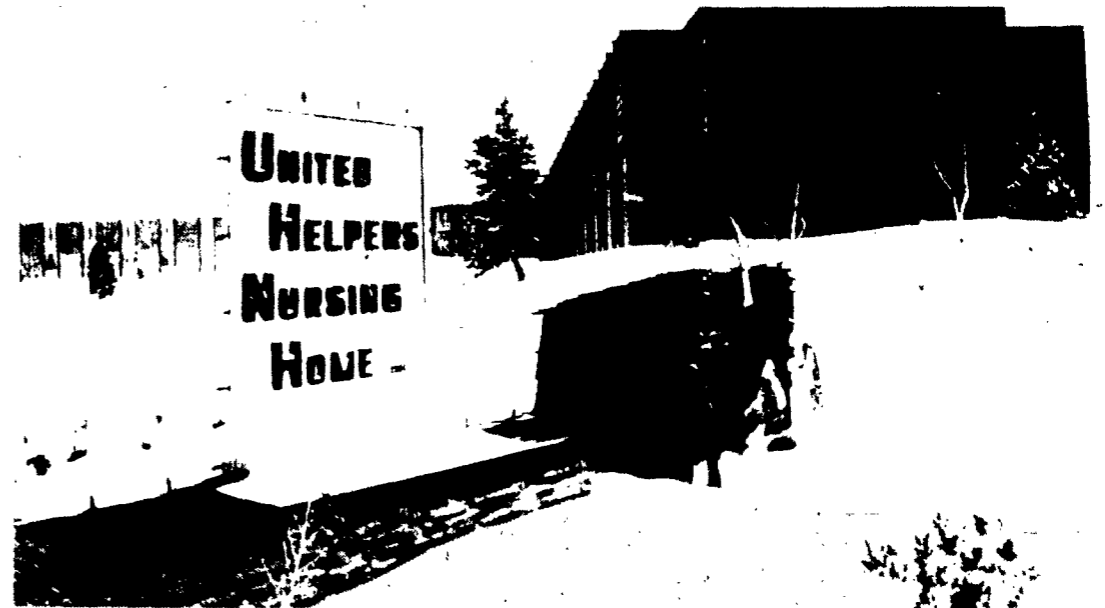

## THE UNITED HELPERS ADULT HOME

The United Helpers Adult Home located on Riverside Drive, Ogdensburg, New York is a forty (40) bed facility which offers assistance in daily living, such as housekeeping services, laundry and dietary needs, but no nursing care. All meals are served in a central dining room with evening nourishments offered in individual rooms. A daily activity program spanning up to fifty (50) hours per month, is made available to the residents, including exercise program, social hours, bingo, bowling tournaments, church services and many more.

The Administrator, Beverly Barley is responsible for overseeing the \$475,000 Operational budget of United Helpers Adult Home which includes a payroll for twenty-one (21) employees in excess of \$160,000. A home like atmosphere is endeavored to be maintained with resident input and the dedication of the well-trained staff.

## THE UNITED HELPERS NURSING HOME, INC.

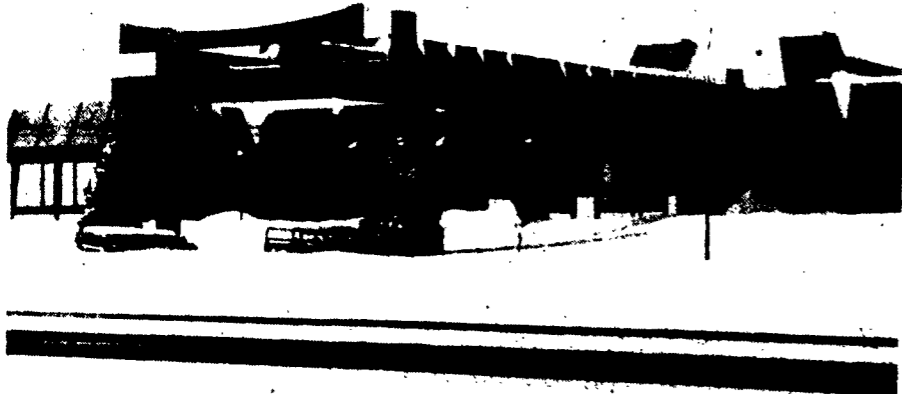
The United Helpers Nursing Home, Inc. provides a wide range of services for the 120 citizens residing there.

To encourage the rehabilitation of the residents and to promote maximal physical, social and emotional functioning, the nursing staff along with the other diverse departments, offer the residents an opportunity to benefit from a totally coordinated care program.

This is accomplished by the various departments: Nursing, Physical Therapy, Dietary, Housekeeping, Maintenance, Activities and Administration combining their expertise and working as a team.

United Helpers Nursing Home, Inc. employs 109 people and operates on an annual budget of \$1,971,618 with a payroll budget constituting \$975,790.

The Administrator of this facility is Ned Hirt.

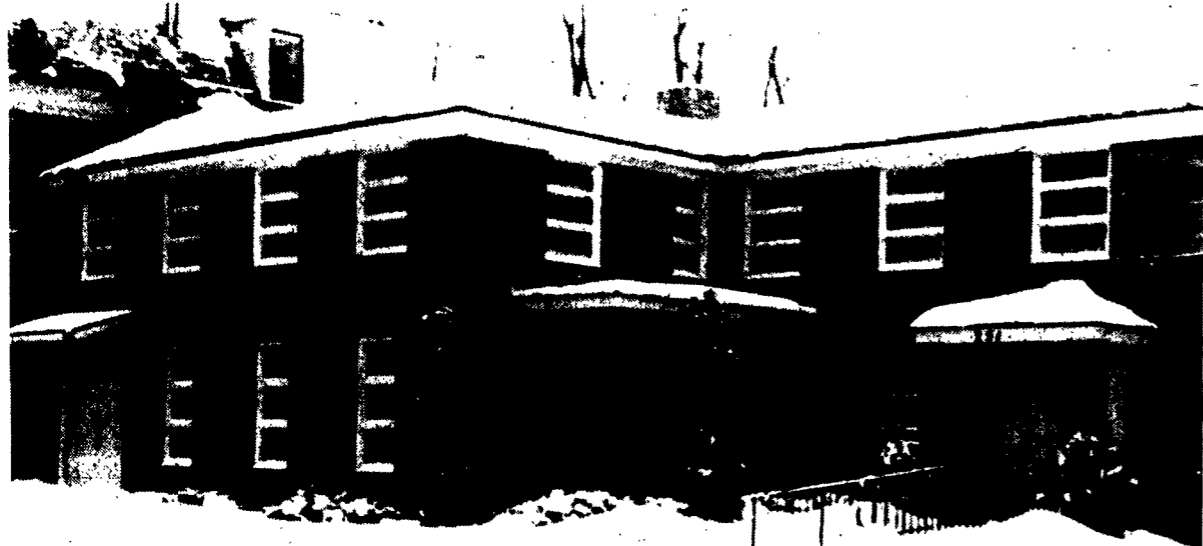


## THE UNITED HELPERS CANTON NURSING HOME, INC.

The United Helpers Canton Nursing Home, Inc. is a 160 bed nursing home in Canton, New York. This facility, which opened in December of 1973 as Moongate Nursing Home, provides 80 skilled nursing beds, 80 health related beds and an Outpatient Physical Therapy Department with a total annual budget of approximately 2.8 million dollars. The Home currently employs approximately 174 employees with an annual payroll of \$1,539,000. Visitors are always welcome. ## THE UNITED HELPERS CEDARS NURSING HOME

The United Helpers Cedars Nursing Home located on Riverside Drive, Ogdensburg, with its expansive lawns and colorful flower beds, represents home to the 82 patients who come to us from various occupations and counties of New York State. This skilled nursing facility provides high quality nursing care twenty-four hours a day, 365 days a year; an up-to-date physical therapy department, and an activities program that spans over 60 activities a month. The administrator, Cindy Barlow, is responsible for overseeing the 1.8 million dollar operational budget of the Cedars, which includes a payroll in excess of \$900,000. For the well trained and conscientious staff who number 105, and for the patients they care for, the Cedars is the place to work and live.



## THE UNITED HELPERS INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITY, INC.

The United Helpers Intermediate Care Facility, Inc. is a 14 bed facility serving the needs of developmentally disabled individuals.

The United Helpers Intermediate Care Facility, Inc. employs twenty-two (22) people, full or part-time. In addition, five professionals from different disciplines are employed on a consulting basis. The facility operates on an annual budget of \$459,490.

Services provided at the Intermediate Care Facility include habilitation, speech and hearing, physical therapy, occupational therapy, psychology, recreational, dietetic, social service and medical.

The Administrator for this Facility is Roderic O. Roca.

## THE UNITED HELPERS MANAGEMENT COMPANY

Each member corporation contracts with the Society of United Helpers holding corporation for data processing, bookkeeping, financial management services, food service and administration services.

Edward Norris is president of the Society of United Helpers; Robert Russell is chief executive officer and Robert Martin is chief financial officer. The executive offices, located at the corner of Ford and Hamilton Sts., opened last April.
