St. Mary's Receives Tuition Grants

St. Mary's School in Potsdam received a total of \$3,184.58 from the Bishop's Fund Office for Tuition Assistance to children attending Catholic schools it was announced recently by Sister Loretta, principal.

Thirteen families were recipients of the tuition assistance payments. Sister Loretta, in announcing the grants, expressed sincere gratitude to the generous contributors of the 1984 Bishop's Fund by making these grants possible.

The goal for the 1984 Bishop's Fund was set at \$598,000. The

amount allocated for the Tuition Assistance Program is set at \$94,000.

The tuition assistance program for Catholic schools was started in 1969 as a plan to return some of the funds collected through the Bishop's Fund Appeal to help parents in need.

Since that time, \$1,062,826 has been used for tuition assistance. At the same time, the parishes which are hard pressed to meet the full tuition cost of operating a Catholic school in the face of the parents' inability to pay are helped. A condi-

tion of receiving this aid is that the school charge a tuition fee.

A total of 28 schools benefited from the Tuition Assistance Fund this semester with a total of 502 grants awarded to the parents of the children in our three Catholic high schools and 25 elementary schools in the Diocese of Ogdensburg.

The Bishop's Fund Appeal is an annual Drive in all of the parishes of the Diocese of Ogdensburg in September to aid the people of the North Country in their needs.
