North Planned Parenthood Reps To Join Lobbying Efforts In Albany

Planned Parenthood of Northern New York Inc., will travel to Albany in January to take part in one of New York's largest lobbying efforts—the eighth annual Family Planning Advocates Legislature Conference.

This year's conference theme, "Beyond Rhetoric: Addressing Realities" will present workshops and panel discussions of issues including adolescent pregnancy


prevention, expansion of family life education programs, and continued Medicaid funding of abortion.

Pro-choice organizations from across the state will be convening at the Empire State Plaza on Jan. 28 for the two-day event which is expected to include a welcoming address from Secretary of State Gail Shaffer, Senate Majority Leader Warren Anderson, and Assembly Speaker Stanley Fink.

Also on Monday, the delegates will hear keynote speaker Pat Schroeder, dean of Congresswomen and member of the Select Committee on Children, Youth, and Families, speak on the topic "Pro-Family Rhetoric: Anti-Family Policies."

Tuesday's highlight will be a luncheon panel, "Protecting Conflicting Values In A Pluralistic Society," Dr. Daniel Callahan, director


