

# Flyers Hold Off Strong Stoner Effort

A poor shooting night from the floor and a gutsy Potsdam squad staved off a strong effort by the Norfolk girls basketball team last night. But the Flyers kept plugging and came away with a 47-29 NAC Division I win in Potsdam.

Outscoring their hosts 20-8 over the final 8:00, the Flyers pulled away from a close 27-21 lead at the end of three quarters. Potsdam was pesky, trailing 6-4, and 12-10 at the first two quarter breaks.

Leading the way for N-N with a spectacular all-around performance in the second half was sophomore Lyn Reed. Reed scored all 15 of her points in the second half and added a host of steals, assists, and rebounds.

Fellow sophomores Lisa Dully and Holly Stone added fine games with 14 and six points, respectively.

The force inside, Mary Connelly, connected on all 10 of her points in the second half.

The Stoners were led by improving junior forward Katie Baker with 11 points, while junior Kelly Norman contributed six and Jen Dumas helped out with four.

"We played very well for three quarters and a half. They just wore us down with their man-to-man press," said Stoner Coach Hal Gillette.

"I was pleased with the way we played, but when we lost Belinda Martin to fouls, we were thin inside because our bench is not strong yet. Kelly (Norman) plays well every game and Katie (Baker) is getting better each time out. With Sarah (Spencer) out with a knee injury, we have to find a consistent inside scoring threat."

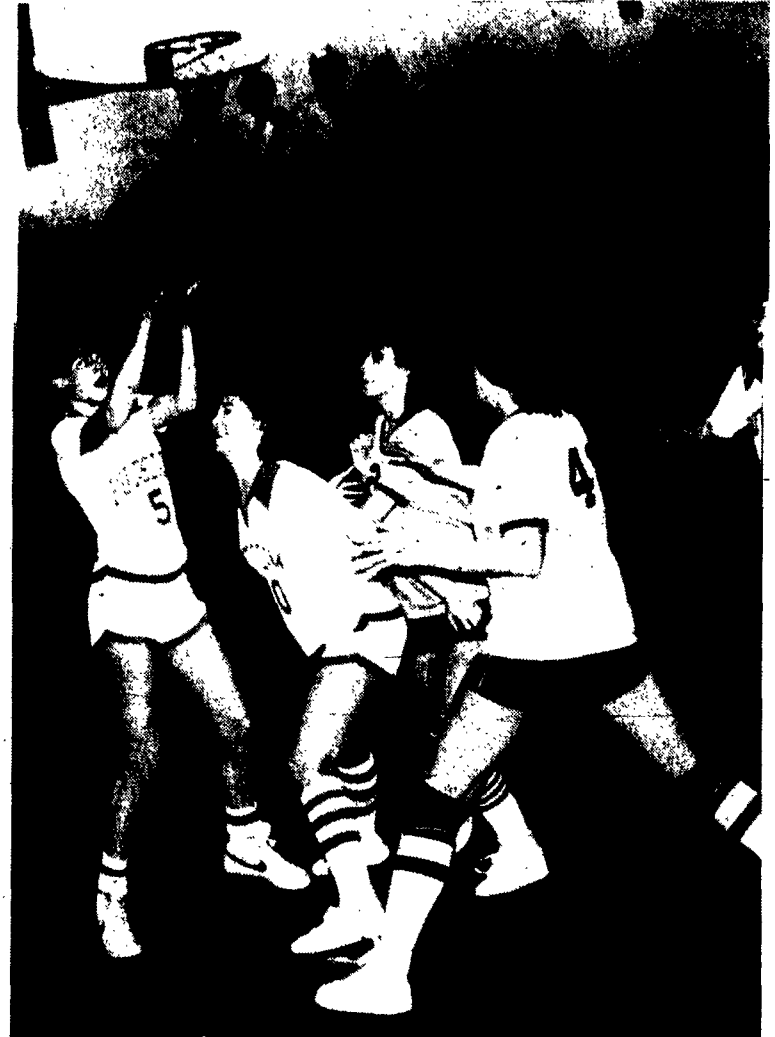

Both alpine and cross country conditions are just great. While it is always impossible to separate weather and ski conditions, the relatively mild weather with lots of snow has made everything just right frequently this winter. Other than a few bad windy days, the weather can be described as "nice and cold."

I skied Big Tupper this past Saturday, and the conditions there were about as good as I have ever seen them there for this time of year. The temperature was about 28 degrees, the wind was calm, and the sun was out all day. Since Tupper received about four or five inches the night before, the area had marvelous packed powder surfaces.
