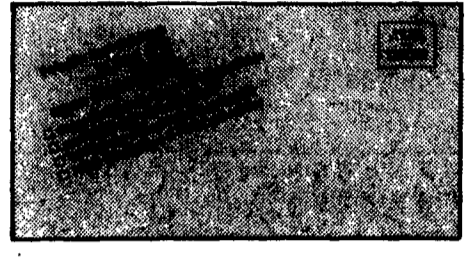
He is predeceased by a brother, Roland.

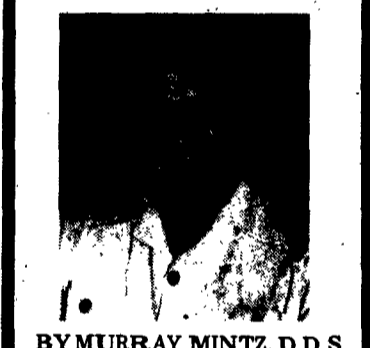

## ASK DR. MINTZ

**WHICH TOOTHBRUSH?**  
Q. Soft, medium or hard bristle toothbrushes — which is best?  
A. It used to be that many dentists recommended a brush with stiff bristles. But, improperly used, those brushes can cause damage. The consensus among dentists today is that a brush with soft nylon bristles is preferable because medium or hard bristles are more likely to irritate sensitive gum tissue and wear away enamel.  
A brush should have at least three rows of small, double-rounded bristles to provide a flat brushing surface and the entire head should be small enough to get into the mouth's hard-to-reach spaces. Keep in mind that the appropriate brush is only as effective as the way it is used — how well and how often — and that dental floss is its indispensable partner.
