

# Henry Leads Flyers To Can-Am Title

At the 4:33 mark in the first quarter, Massena Central point-guard Marc Macaulay was on the floor and in considerable pain in last Tuesday's championship game of the Massena Can-Am Christmas Basketball Tournament.

Macaulay, a senior co-captain, left the game at that point and did not return after suffering a painful upper back bruise.

Enter Norwood-Norfolk's Scott Henry.

The crafty Flyer swingman and All-Tourney selection, fired missile after missile through the target, exploding for a 28 point night, including 14 points in the second quarter, lifting Coach Jimmy Myers club to an emotional 58-45 win over a 6-2 Raider quintet.

Scoring seven times in the second quarter from the foul line, the Flyers clung to a 30-29 halftime lead over a pesky Raider crew that received fine back-court play from Scott Griffin, Bob Ahlfeld, Kenin Sharlow, and Craig Badger in the absence of Macaulay.

To the qualified voters of the Potsdam Central School District, please take notice that the Board of Education of the Potsdam Central School District has called for a Special Meeting of the District to be held in the auditorium of the Potsdam Central High School, 29 Leroy Street, Potsdam, New York on Tuesday, February 24, 1987 between the hours of 1:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time for the purpose of voting on the following proposition:

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

**RESOLVED, THAT** the Board of Education of Potsdam Central School, St. Lawrence County, New York, is hereby authorized to undertake the following capital improvement program:

(a) reconstruction and renovation of various school district buildings located throughout and in the said district, including site work and the purchase and installation of original equipment and furnishings required for the purposes for which such reconstructed buildings will be used at a maximum estimated cost of \$2,375,000; and

(b) the reconstruction of the track at the high school at a maximum estimated cost of \$27,000, and that the sum of \$425,000 from the Potsdam Central School District Capital Reserve Fund shall be appropriated to pay part of the cost thereof, and that the remainder in the amount of \$2,375,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary, be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of said school district and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law; and in anticipation of such tax and Capital Reserve Fund expenditure, obligations of said school district shall be issued in an amount not to exceed \$2,800,000.
