The Rev. Robert Tierney officiated at the ceremony in St. Rita's Church, Binghamton.

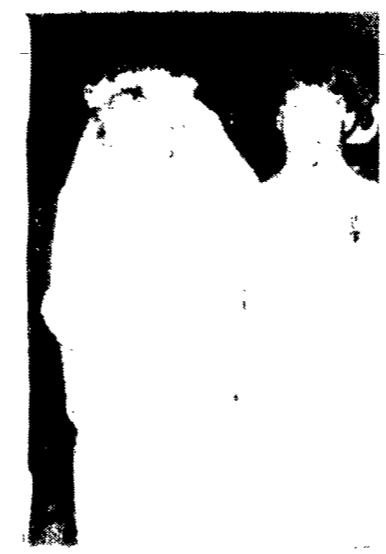
Matron of honor was Jan Ford. Flower girls were Misty Jenks, niece of the bridegroom and Margaret Doll, cousin of the bride.

An August wedding is planned.



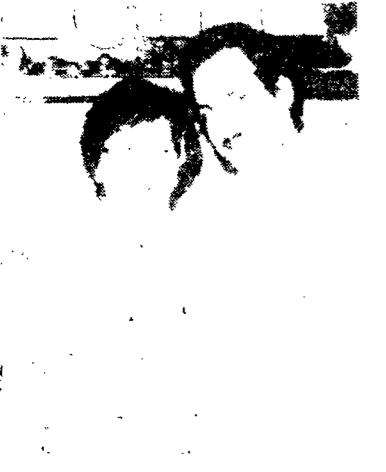
